Extension of the first country cooperation framework the for Marshall Islands

Note by the Administrator

Period of extension: 1 January 2002 through 31 December 2002

I. Background and justification

- 1. At its third regular session 1997, the Executive Board approved the first country cooperation framework (CCF) for the Marshall Islands. A one-year extension of the first CCF has been requested, to enable the formulation of the second CCF within the context of the United Nations Development Assistance Framework and to synchronize the period of the second CCF with the programming cycles of other United Nations agencies in the country.
- 2. The main thematic areas of the first CCF, namely, informal employment generation and sustainable livelihoods, governance and environment continue to remain valid.

II. Objectives

3. Within the framework of the first CCF, UNDP will continue to provide support in informal employment

generation and sustainable livelihoods, through small business advisory services and entrepreneurial training, and facilitating the access of small-scale producers to marketing, credit, transportation and related services. These services will continue and further efforts will be made to enter into partnerships with local governments, to assist with the utilization of outer-island resources for employment and support for livelihoods. In the area of governance, specific support will continue in capacity-building for the collection and utilization of statistics, in order to ensure that social statistics are used for national development planning and to help to reduce any negative impact of economic reform programmes. With funding from the Global Environment Facility, the Marshall Islands has prepared National Biodiversity Strategy and Action Plan, and the report has been submitted to the Conference on Biological Diversity. UNDP will further strengthen its support in this area, through the formulation of proposals for add-on funds and capacity-building, to implement the recommendations

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of the National Biodiversity Strategy and Action Plan, through national development plans.

III. Recommendation

4. The Administrator wishes to inform the Executive Board that he has approved the extension of the first country cooperation framework for the Marshall Islands for a period of one year, 1 January 2002 through 31 December 2002.
