## Annual statistical report 2001\*

## Procurement of goods and services, international project personnel, UNV volunteers, and fellowships

- 1. The present report, covering procurement data of the United Nations system, is submitted by the Administrator to the Executive Board pursuant to its decision 96/2. The report may be obtained in the language of submission (English only) from the Executive Board secretariat or downloaded from the web site of the Inter-Agency Procurement Services Office at www.iapso.org/information/publications.asp.
- 2. The main purpose of the report is to provide details on procurement by country of supply to the United Nations system.
- 3. Total procurement by the United Nations system under all sources of funding in 2001 was \$4.6 billion, of which the share from developing countries was 38 per cent. Under UNDP funding, total procurement in 2001 was \$949 million, of which the share from developing countries was 56 per cent.
- 4. The annual statistical report 2001 features the following new additions:
- (a) A section covering major equipment (more than \$30 000) and services procured by the United Nations system;
- (b) List of top ten product groups/items procured by the United Nations system;
- (c) Revised and improved summary sheets of the Member countries of the Development Assistance Committee of the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development;
- (d) Graphical representation of the top ten contributors to UNDP regular resources and their respective procurement volumes;
- (e) Procurement under the direct execution modality.
