Extension of the first country cooperation framework for Sierra Leone

Note by the Administrator

Period of extension: 1 January 2003 to 31 December 2003

Summary

Using the streamlined format introduced at the first regular session of the Executive Board in January 2002, this note contains information on the extension of country cooperation frameworks requested since the last meeting of the Board. Only the Government of Sierra Leone has made such a request.

The Administrator wishes to inform the Executive Board that he has approved the extension of the first country cooperation framework for Sierra Leone for a period of one year, from 1 January 2003 to 31 December 2003. The attached table summarises the reasons given for the CCF extension.

The Executive Board may wish to take note of this extension of the CCF.
