Paragraph 5 should read

Many challenges remain with respect to land use planning, natural resources management and sustainable development. The country's progress in expanding its industrial and manufacturing base has resulted in growing environmental threats, such as the pollution of waterways from increasing use of pesticides, herbicides and fertilizers; contamination of terrestrial and marine biodiversity; and rapid deforestation. These all amount to major concerns. Added to this are the negative impacts of toxic and hazardous waste disposal, land degradation and the growing threat of global warming.
