## Introduction

1. The annual financial review summarizes the information included in the UNFPA financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2002. Information on the operations funded by UNFPA regular and other resources, which include trust funds, is included in the financial statements.
2. The statements 'Income and Expenditures and Fund Balances for the year ended 31 December 2002' are provided in Table 1 for regular and other resources and Table 2 for other resources by category. The statement 'Assets, Liabilities and Fund Balances for the year ended 31 December 2002' is provided in Table 3.\*

### I. REGULAR RESOURCES

#### A. Income

3. Contribution income for the year was \$250.1 million (in 2001 it was \$258.3 million). The decrease of \$8.2 million or 3.2 per cent would have been greater without the support of the donor community following the decision by a major donor to withdraw funding completely at the beginning of 2002, and had the US dollar not depreciated in value over the year.
4. At 31 December 2002, a provision of \$0.7 million (in 2001 it was nil) was made in respect of contributions receivable for which collection was considered doubtful.
5. Falling interest rates gave rise to reduced interest income of \$5.8 million for the year compared to \$9.7 million in 2001. Other income to regular resources of \$4.2 million (in 2001 it was \$0.6 million) comprised exchange rate gains on items other than contributions and savings on the liquidation of obligations raised in the previous biennium.
6. Tables 4 and 5 provide details of contributions in excess of \$1.0 million.

#### B. Programme expenditure

7. At the second regular session 2002, the Executive Board approved programme expenditure authority of \$416.9 million for the biennium ended 31 December 2003.
8. Actual programme expenditure for the year, which includes the direct costs of programme activities, expenditures in respect of the Technical Advisory Programme, and the costs of support services incurred by UNFPA and other executing agencies, totalled \$226.2 million compared to \$194.3 million in 2001.
9. Table 6 and figures 3 and 4 provide further information about programme activities expenditure by region and country.
10. The increase reported under programme expenditure is attributable in major part to programme activities, specifically implementation by UNFPA which increased by \$20.4 million. Implementation by governments, and by inter-governmental institutions and non-governmental organizations (NGOs) also increased by \$6.0 million and \$6.1 million, respectively.

### C. Biennial support budget

13. At the second regular session 2002, the Executive Board approved revised gross and net biennial support budget (BSB) appropriations of \$155.2 million and \$135.1 million, respectively.

15. The decrease in credits to the BSB of \$2.5 million was attributable in large part to the non-reimbursement of income tax charges incurred by UNFPA staff members following the withdrawal of funding to UNFPA by the Government of the country in which these staff members reside, and negotiated waivers of support service income from co-financing contributions.

17. Net appropriations utilized for the year ended 31 December 2002 were 48.4 per cent of the revised BSB 2002-2003. The unencumbered balance of net appropriations at 31 December 2002 was \$69.7 million.

#### D. Implementation of the Enterprise Resource Planning system

18. At the second regular session 2002, the Executive Board authorized the setting aside of \$10.0 million for the implementation of the Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) system. The ERP project will allow integration of financial, accounting and programme finances, provide budget formulation modules both for programme purposes and for the biennial support budget in all locations, provide tools for human resource management at international and local levels and provide balanced scorecard and key performance indicator functions.

19. Expenditures of \$1.3 million were incurred in the year ending 31 December 2002.

#### E. Fund balances and reserves

20. The balance of programmable funds at 1 January 2002 was \$39.8 million (in 2001 it was \$53.2 million). Total expenditures exceeded income for the year by \$33.6 million (in 2001 income exceeded expenditures by \$14.4 million) and, together with other reserve movements, reduced the balance of programmable funds to \$6.6 million at 31 December 2002, compared to \$39.8 million in 2001.

21. At 31 December 2002, the operational reserve was decreased to \$50.0 million (in 2001 it was \$51.7 million).

## II. OTHER RESOURCES

### A. Income and expenditures

22. Total income to other resources during the year was \$113.0 million (in 2001 it was \$127.8 million) comprising contributions of \$109.5 million (in 2001 it was \$123.5 million) and other income including interest of \$3.5 million (in 2001 it was \$4.3 million). Total expenditures during the year were \$117.2 million compared to \$123.3 million in 2001.

### B. Fund balances

23. The deficit of income over expenditure for the year of \$4.2 million (in 2001 there was a surplus of \$4.5 million), together with refunds to donors of \$6.4 million (in 2001 it was \$4.2 million) and a net transfer to regular resources of \$3.9 million (in 2001 it was \$2.2 million), resulted in a decrease in other resources fund balances from \$137.6 million in 2001 to \$123.1 million in 2002.

#### *Cost-sharing*

24. Cost-sharing contributions for the year totalled \$43.9 million compared to \$12.5 million in 2001. This represented 40.1 per cent of all contributions to other resources in the year ended 31 December 2002, compared to 10.1 per cent in 2001.

25. The balance of cost-sharing funds held at 31 December 2002 was \$24.1 million (in 2001 it was \$12.9 million).

26. Trust fund activity can be summarized as follows:

27. Contributions to trust funds decreased by \$45.5 million. This decrease is to some extent offset by the increase in cost-sharing contributions (see paragraph 24).

## III. CASH AND INVESTMENTS

28. At 31 December 2002, investments held by UNFPA totalled \$138.9 million under regular resources, compared to \$131.4 million in 2001, and \$169.2 million under other resources, compared to \$187.0 million in 2001. Cash held under regular resources totalled \$3.7 million (in 2001 it was \$8.3 million). The market value of investments held at 31 December 2002 was \$309.4 million.

Regular Resources - Income and Expenditure (1993 - 2002)

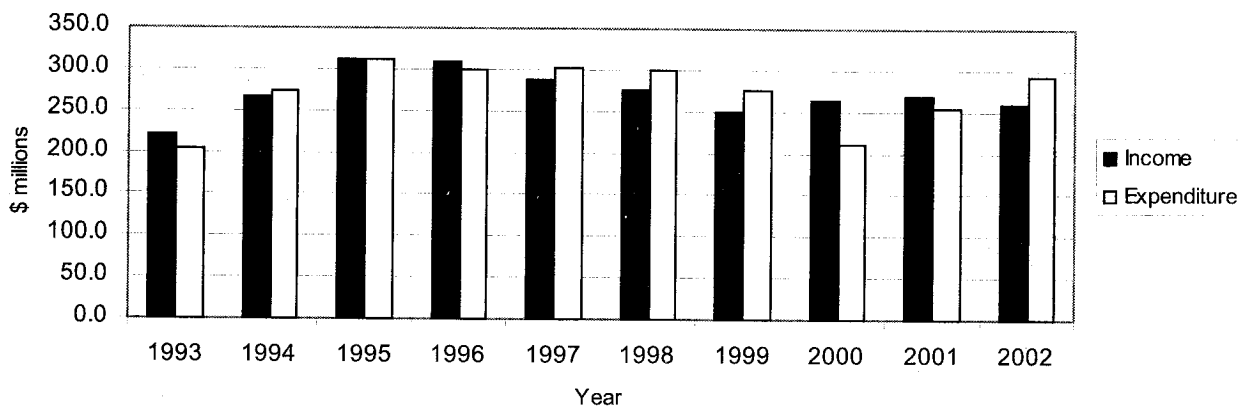

Regular Resources - Programme Activities Expenditure by Type

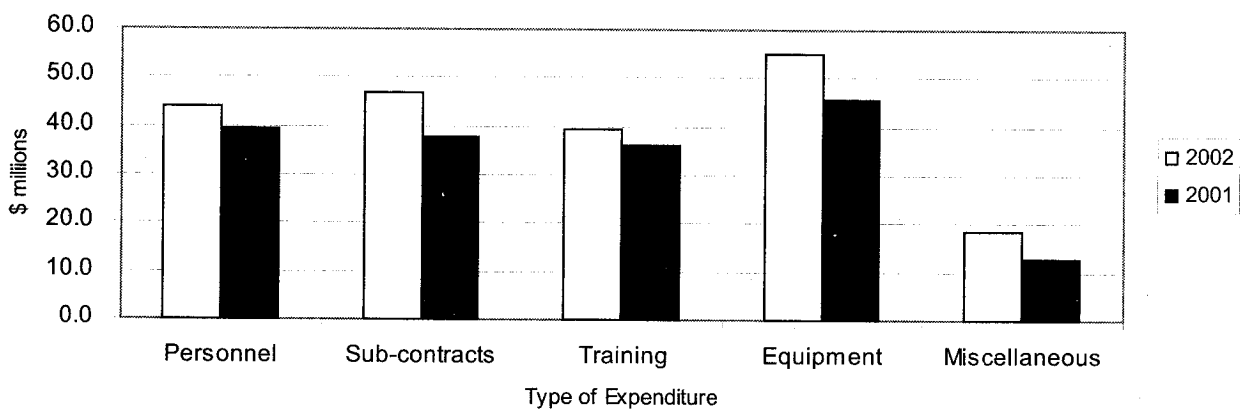

Regular Resources - Programme Activities Expenditure by Region

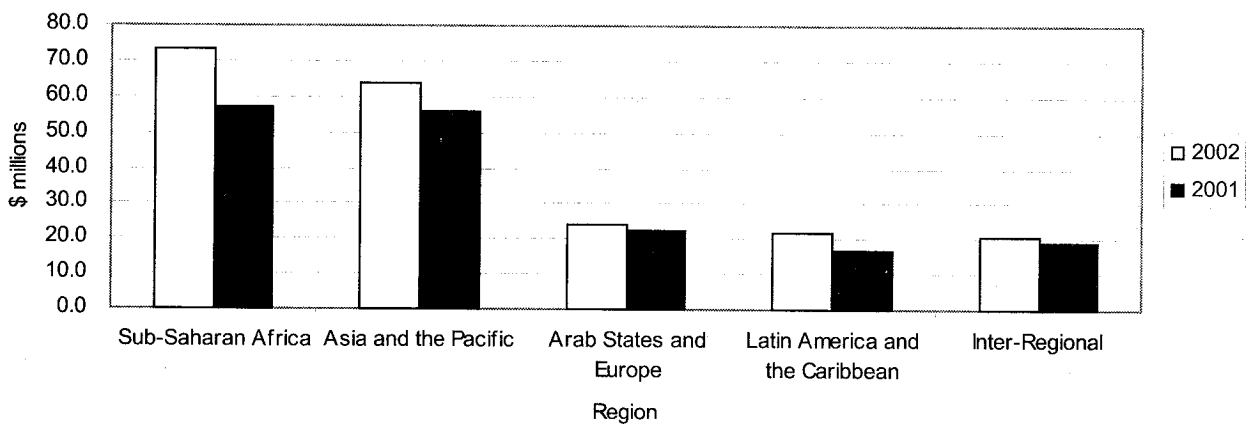
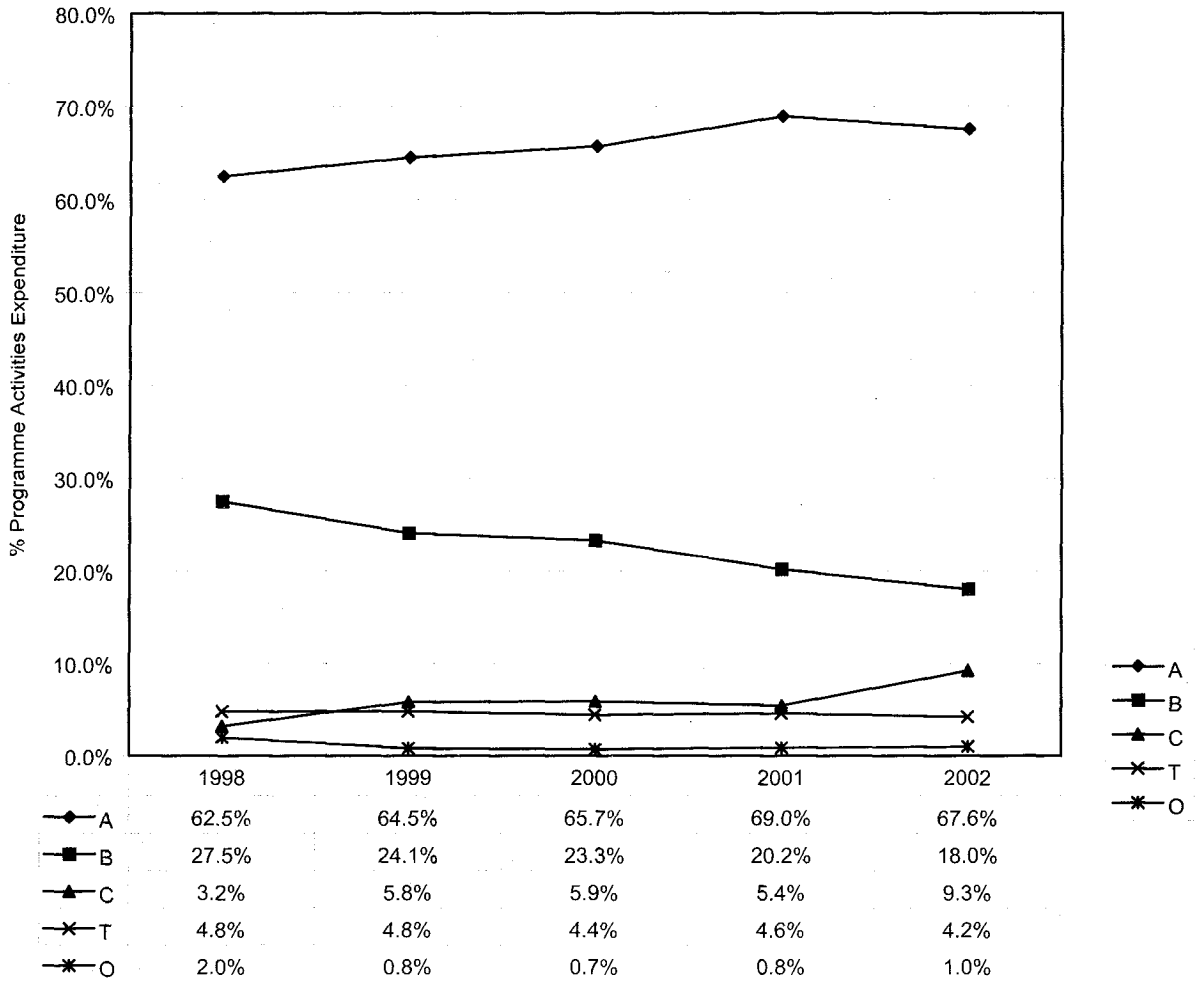
