## DRAFT WORK PLAN FOR THE EXECUTIVE BOARD IN 1999

## INTRODUCTION

- 1. In accordance with decision 96/25, the present document contains a preliminary draft work plan for the UNDP/UNFPA Executive Board work during 1999. It includes an outline of priority issues for both UNDP and UNFPA with an initial indication of the session at which the issues may be considered by the Board, taking into account any relevant prior decisions as well as the Board's request to focus deliberations at each session.
- 2. This draft work plan should be considered preliminary in that the Executive Board will consider several important matters at the third regular session 1998. Among them are funding strategies for both UNDP and UNFPA, which are being considered pursuant to General Assembly resolution 50/227, Economic and Social Council resolution 1997/59 of 24 July 1997, and Executive Board decisions 98/3 (concerning UNDP) and 98/7 (concerning UNFPA). Decisions taken at the third regular session 1998 on these and other matters will be reflected in a revised work plan presented to the Board at the first regular session 1999 for official adoption.
