Annual statistical report, 1999

Procurement of goods and services, international project personnel, United Nations Volunteers and fellowships

The Annual statistical report, covering procurement data of the United Nations system, is submitted by the Administrator for the information of the Executive Board. The report may be obtained in the language of submission (English only) from the Executive Board secretariat.

The main purpose of the report is to provide details on procurement by country of supply to the United Nations system.

Total procurement by the United Nations system under all sources of funding during 1998 was \$3.0 billion and the share of procurement from developing countries was 42 per cent. The percentage share of procurement from developing countries has been increasing steadily over the past few years. Under UNDP funding, the corresponding figure for the share of procurement from developing countries was 85 per cent.

As of July 1999, the collection of data for 1999 procurement was still in progress.
