SUMMARY

The present report provides summary financial information on all active trust funds as at 31 December 1995 and brief information on all trust funds established by the Administrator in 1995.

Table 1 contains summary financial information on all trust funds in operation during 1995. There were 103 trust funds in operation during 1995. Of these, 1 was closed by 31 December 1995. Aggregate income received during the year for these trust funds amounted to \$225,532,530 and total expenditure incurred amounted to \$181,221,527.

Table 2 contains information on those trust funds and sub-trust funds established by the Administrator in 1995 and a brief description of their activities. There were 25 trust funds established by the Administrator in 1995. In addition, 27 new sub-trust funds were established under existing Funds and trust funds.

In accordance with Financial Regulation 5.1, the present report will be submitted to the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary questions, for its comments on table 2.

The Executive Board may wish to take note of the present addendum.
