4. The Executive Director therefore requests that the Governing Council authorize the net additional approval authority, as listed below, for the years 1981, 1982 and 1983.

5. The Executive Director recommends that the Governing Council authorize the net additional approval authority in the amount of:

(a) \$78 million for 1981, to bring the total for 1981 from \$128 million in 1980 to \$147 million; and

 (b) \$75.75 million for 1982 and \$73.5 million for 1983, to permit the approval of projects for more than one year.

6. The Executive Director also requests the Governing Council to authorize him to increase the net additional authority for 1981 by an additional \$12 million if new additional resources, over and above those required to reach the authority level set in paragraph 5 above, are pledged or otherwise are provided to UNFPA prior to the next meeting of the Governing Council.

7. The Executive Director wishes to reassure the Governing Council that, in accordance with the decisions of the Council, all approvals of projects will be limited to the availability of resources.
