SECTORAL SUPPORT

Draft decision

The Governing Council,

(a) <u>Takes note</u> of the report of the Administrator on sectoral support (DP/480) and of the views and comments of members thereon;

(b) <u>Decides</u> to increase the allocation to cover the net additional costs for SIDFAs in 1980-1981 to \$7,962,000 and the total allocation for sectoral support for the biennium, 1980-1981, to \$11,712,000;

(c) <u>Requests</u> the Administrator to enter into negotiations with Governments so that, for the third programme cycle, 1982-1986, part of the cost of the SIDFA programme be financed from national IPFs, the cost to each Government being proportionate to the services received;

(d) <u>Decides</u> to review the entire question of the UNDP financing of sectoral support;

(e) <u>Invites</u> UNIDO to provide the necessary financial resources to ensure that all SIDFAs, particularly those who cover more than one country, are able to undertake the travel which is necessary for the effective performance of their duties;

(f) <u>Requests</u> the idministrator, in consultation with the Executive Director of UNIDO, to revise the list of possible SIDFA services contained in the annex to DP/480, and to submit such a list to the twenty-eighth session of the Governing Council for its comments;

(g) <u>Further requests</u> the Administrator, in consultation with the Executive Director of UNIDO, when recruiting SIDFAs, to give primary consideration to the technical competence and experience of the individuals concerned, while at the same time recruiting from as wide a range of countries as possible, particularly
