BUDGETARY, ADMINISTRATIVE AND FINANCIAL MATTERS Review of the Integrated Systems Improvement Project (ISIP) Draft decision

The Governing Council,

1. <u>Takes note</u> with appreciation of the progress of the Integrated Systems Improvement Project (ISIP), the arrangements for the transfer of the functions of the ISIP Group to the Division of Management Information Systems (DMIS), and the status of the funds appropriated for 1979 and 1980, as contained in the Administrator's Report (DP/471), and the views and comments of the members thereon;

 <u>Expresses</u> its satisfaction with the implementation of Phase II of ISIP, particularly the fact that most of the systems will be operational by the end of 1980;
<u>Further notes</u> the intention of the Administrator to review, in the near future, the role and functions of DMIS, including the level of staff and other resources that may be required to ensure the successful completion, maintenance, operation and enhancement of UNDP's information systems and <u>requests</u> the Administrator to bring the results of this review to the attention of the Council in June 1981.
