ASSISTANCE FOR THE REHABILITATION AND RECONSTRUCTION OF UGANDA

DRAFT DECISION

## The Governing Council,

<u>Recalling</u> General Assembly resolution 34/122, Assistance for the reconstruction, rehabilitation and development of Uganda, in particular operative paragraphs 6 and 11 thereof,

<u>Deeply concerned</u> about the continuing deterioration of the economic and social conditions in Uganda,

Bearing in mind that Uganda's IPF for the third programming cycle, 1982-1986, has not yet been calculated due to non-availability of basic data to determine basic criteria,

 <u>Takes note</u> of the assurances given by the Administrator that every effort will be made, within the authority already delegated to him, to accommodate the additional needs of the Uganda Government;
<u>Decides</u> to review Uganda's situation at its twenty-eighth session, and <u>requests</u> the Administrator to prepare, for that purpose, a report on the implementation of UNDP assistance to Uganda.
