Assistance to Lebanon

Draft decision submitted by Austria, Belgium, Colombia, Cuba, Egypt, France, Greece, India, Kuwait, Liberia, Pakistan, Romania and Yemen

The Governing Council,

Recalling decision 80/30,

Considering the difficult situation of Lebanon and the urgent need for its development,

<u>Convinced</u> that, unless a concerted effort is undertaken to assist Lebanon in overcoming its present difficulties, the adverse effect on its future development can cause serious problems in the region,

Decides to defer the determination of the illustrative indicative planning figure for Lebanon until the twenty-ninth session of the Council, and to consider, at that time, this question as a matter of priority and with a view to increasing UNDP assistance.
