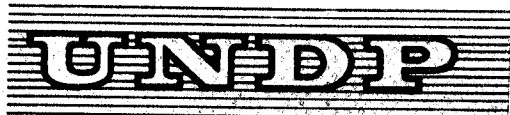

Explanatory Note

1. In response to Governing Council decision 79/22, the tables which follow include a summary of statistics on technical co-operation project activities of organizational entities of the United Nations, and detailed information for the Department of Technical Co-operation for Development (DTCD). The report has been prepared in a format largely consistent with two other reports currently before the Governing Council, documents DP/511 and DP/545, which contain basic programme data for work financed by UNDP, and information on agency regular budget and non-UNDP extrabudgetary technical co-operation activities.
2. The definitions used in the tables of the above-mentioned reports apply here, as regards "UNDP" and "other extrabudgetary" resources. However the "regular budget" information given here applies to the United Nations Regular Programme of Technical Co-operation only, which is the portion of the regular budget of the United Nations specifically set aside for technical co-operation purposes.
3. Financial data in the present document have been derived from the year-end financial records available at Headquarters, and refer to project activities only, organized by executing agency. The amounts given below therefore are not necessarily identical to those in DP/511, which has been prepared on the basis of provisional figures submitted by responding agencies. Also the information requested by UNDP for use in document DP/545 was not yet available at the time of writing.
4. The text of Part IV of document DP/RP/23 includes some figures submitted from various organizational entities, indicating certain expenditures, contributions received or pledges made in support of activities. Since this information is not complete and does not entirely correspond with that derived from the financial records available at Headquarters, such records alone have been used in preparing the present document.

 (In millions of U.S. Dollars)

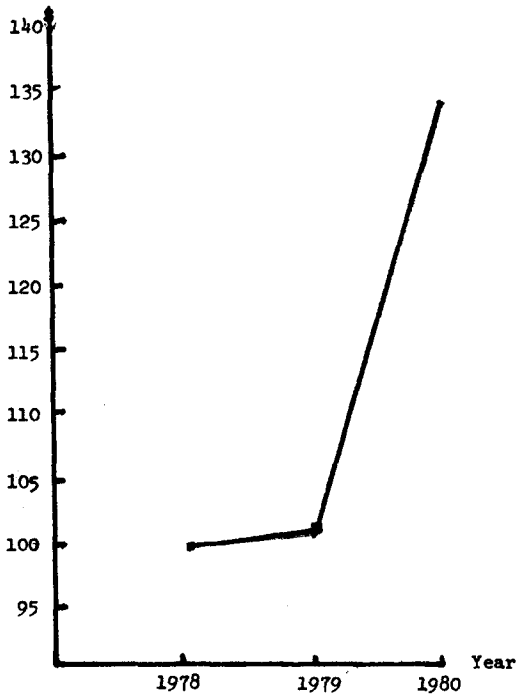


Figure 2. Trend in DTCD Project Expenditures, By Source of Funds
 (In millions of U.S. Dollars)

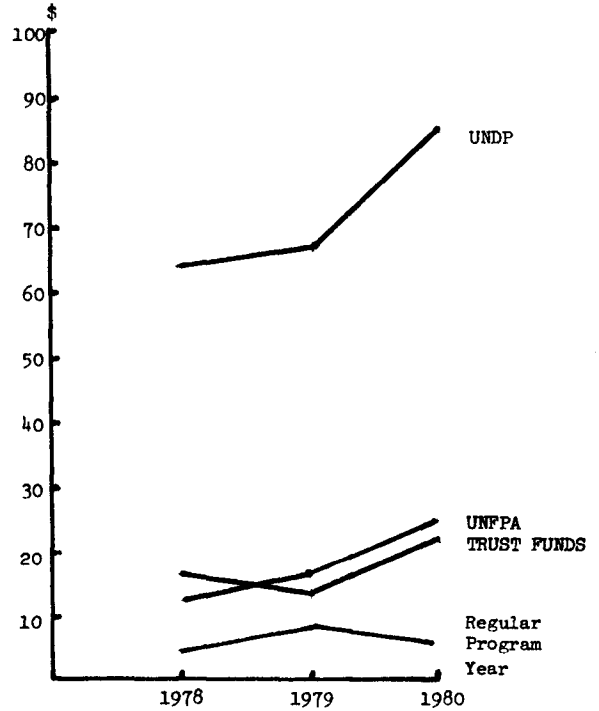


Figure 3. Trend in DTCD Project Expenditures, By General Field of Activity
 (In millions of U.S. Dollars)

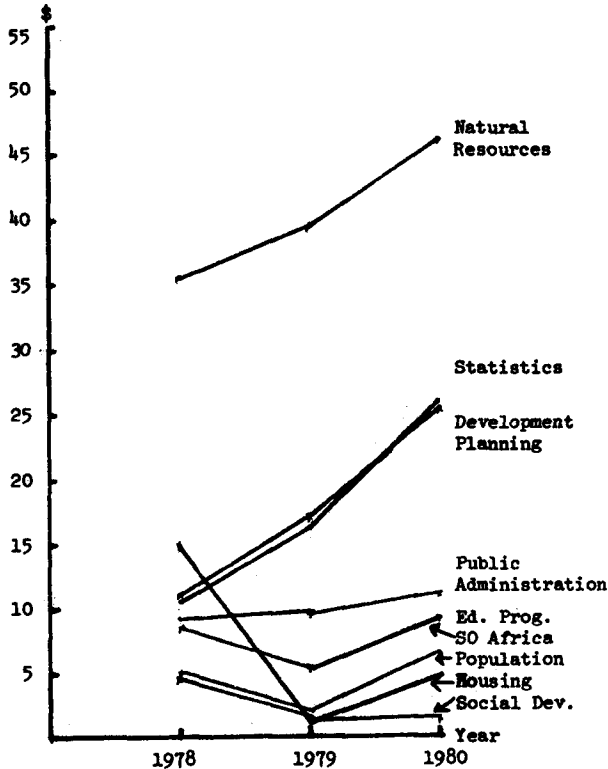


Figure 4. Trend in DTCD Project Expenditures, By Geographic Branch
 (In millions of U.S. Dollars)

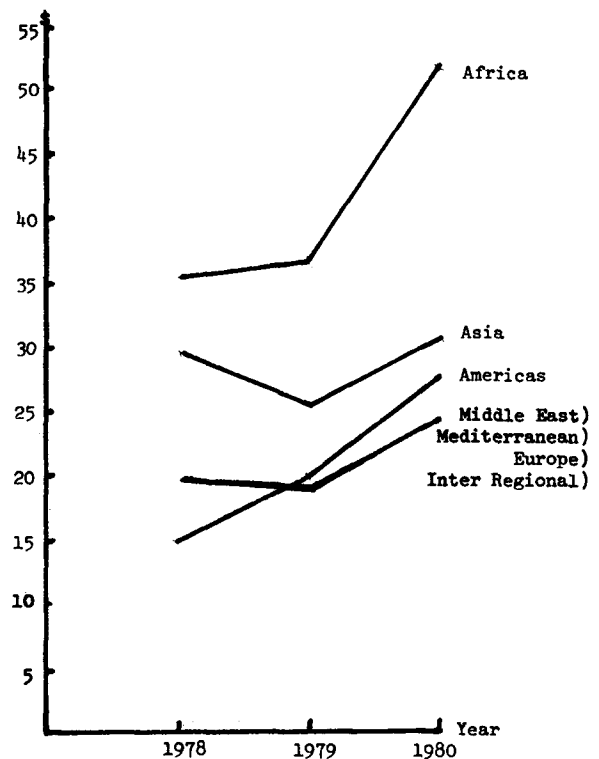

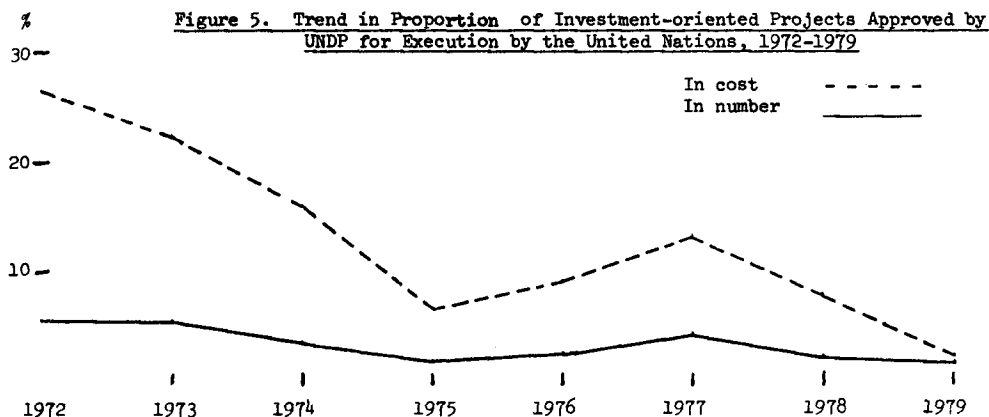
