UNDP DEVELOPMENT STUDY PROGRAMME

Draft decision submitted by Argentina, Austria, Bangladesh, Bhutan, China, Ecuador, Gabon, Malaysia, Pakistan, Romania, Rwanda, Somalia, Tunisia, Turkey, Uganda, Venezuela

The Governing Council,

Recalling its decision 81/30 by which it requested the Administrator to establish a UNDP Development Study Programme,

- 1. Welcomes the report of the Administrator on the implementation of this decision and commends him for the action taken to launch the Programme;
- 2. <u>Invites</u> member Governments to support the Study Programme with financial contributions;
- 3. <u>Decides</u> to allocate as seed money \$30,000 from the Special Programme Resources to the trust account of UNDP Study Programme;
- 4. Endorses the Administrator's proposal to convene a Honorary Advisory Committee of the Study Programme to chart future activities and to assist in fund raising for the Study Programme;
- 5. <u>Invites</u> the Administrator to explore possibilities to organize seminars at various venues in the pursuance of the objectives of the Programme;
- 6. <u>Supports</u> the proposal to organize a seminar for parliamentarians attending the sessions of the General Assembly to familiarize them with activities in technical assistance to developing countries:
- 7. Requests the Administrator to report to the Governing Council at its thirtieth session on the implementation of the present decision.
