Assistance to Anguilla

Note by Administrator

- 1. In its decision 80/30, and as confirmed in decision 81/16, the Governing Council approved an illustrative indicative planning figure (IPF) for 1982-1986 for Saint Kitts-Nevis-Anguilla of \$1.3 million.
- 2. In January 1982, the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland informed the Administrator that, under the provisions of the Anguilla Act 1980, the territory of Anguilla was formally separated from the Associated State of St. Christopher, Nevis and Anguilla and had reverted to the status of dependency of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland.
- 3. The Administrator is therefore proposing to the Governing Council the establishment of a separate illustrative IFF for 1982-1986 for Anguilla of \$800,000.
- 4. The separation of Anguilla from Saint Kitts-Nevis-Anguilla would not change the illustrative IPF for 1982-1986 for Saint Kitts-Nevis, which would therefore remain \$1.3 million. The new amount for Anguilla would entirely be taken from the unallocated IPF amount set aside for future participants, etc.
- 5. The amount indicated above results from using the criteria for calculating IPI approved by the Council. Below certain population levels, the resultant IPFs are much higher on a per capita basis than for countries with larger population.
