Note: The relationship between the UNDP-assisted projects and the reported investment commitments are classified by the following three-category classification system:

Category A Relates to reported investment commitments for which the UNDP-assisted project carried out micro-type pre-investment studies such as identification studies, pre-feasibility studies, feasibility studies, final engineering and design, etc., for one or more specific investment projects; programmes.

Category B Relates to reported investment commitments which resulted from UNDP-assisted macro-type studies such as general area or regional planning studies, sector or subsector development studies, natural resources surveys, master plans, etc.

Category C Relates to reported investment commitments for which the UNDP-assisted project is providing technical assistance support, such as assistance in the execution and supervision of reported investment projects, training of required technical staff for the reported investment, etc.
