Report of the Administrator

Summary

The present report is the latest in a series presented to the Governing Council each year since 1973. It responds to decision 81/34 in which the Council requested the Administrator to continue to provide information to it on technical co-operation expenditures of organizations in the United Nations system which are financed from sources other than UNDP.

The report is divided into four sections dealing respectively with the coverage of the report and the nature of the data provided; characteristics of the 1981 expenditures data provided by the specialised agencies; 1981 data on contributions in support of such expenditures; and data which have been made available from other organizations on operational activities in 1981.

The detailed data provided by the United Nations, the specialized agencies, and IAEA on their 1981 non-UNDP technical co-operation activities are contained in the annex. The data are provided by agency, by sector, by recipient country and by source of financing. The country-by-country estimates of United Nations system expenditures on operational activities in 1981 are contained in the final table of the annex (table A.8).

I. INTRODUCTION

- The present report responds to Governing Council decision $81/34\frac{1}{2}$ which, inter alia, requested the Administrator to continue to provide to the Council data on the magnitude and composition of the technical co-operation activities of the United Nations organizations funded from sources other than UNDP, until alternative arrangements for the provision of such data had been made within the United Nations system. Consequently, the present report contains data on the non-UNDP financed technical co-operation expenditures incurred by the specialized agencies and the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) in 1981. As in previous years, these entities have co-operated with UNDP in the preparation of this report by providing the data relating to expenditures and contributions contained in the annex. As in the past three reports of this kind, the present one also contains data on expenditures incurred by two non-technical co-operation bodies, namely the United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF) and the World Food Programme (WFP) as well as certain data on disbursements made by the World Bank and the International Development Association (IDA). It thus gives an overview of the operational activities for development of the United Nations system in 1981. A brief analysis of the nature of the data provided is contained in sections II to IV below.
- The format of the present report follows that of the past two reports of this kind (see DP/488 and DP/545). Two years ago, extensive changes were made in the format, both in order to improve the coverage and to better relate its contents to the data in the annual report on operational activities for development of the United Nations system presented to the General Assembly by the Director-General for Development and International Economic Co-operation $(DIEC)^{2}/$ as well as to the data contained in the report of the Secretary-General on United Nations technical co-operation activities, presented each year to the Governing Council. 3/
- As mentioned in last year's report, $\frac{4}{}$ areas for improved reporting have been identified in the process of providing data on non-UNDP-financed technical co-operation activities to the Governing Council, particularly with respect to the classification of operational activities of the United Nations system by type of activity, the classification of their sources of funding and the standardization of agencies' reporting on expenditures on development These issues were studied by a joint Consultative Committee for Substantive Questions (Operational Activities) (CCSQ(OPS))/Consultative Committee on Administrative Questions (Financial and Budgetary Questions) (CCAQ(FB)) working party convened in December 1980, which made a number of proposals concerning the classification of development activities by type and source of funding as well as the possibility of using a single data base for the three cross-organizational expenditure reports presently prepared in the United Nations system (i.e. the present report, the annual report of the Director-General for DIEC and the ACC report on expenditures in relation to

programmes).5/ The proposals were reviewed by CCAQ(FB) at its fifty-fourth session6/ in March 1981. That committee in turn identified a number of areas where it felt that further study was needed before concrete proposals could be made to the Administrative Committee on Co-ordination (ACC) and decided that, to this end, a working party of CCAQ(FB) should be convened in July 1981. However, the Economic and Social Council, at its second regular session of 1981,7/ requested the Secretary-General to report to it at its first regular session of 1982, with the agreed recommendations of ACC, on means of enhancing the effectiveness of the co-ordination of information systems in the United Nations system, and in this connexion to engage independent experts to prepare recommendations to assist in developing those of ACC. In view, inter alia, of the forthcoming report of the experts which will be presented to the Economic and Social Council's second regular session of 1982, CCAQ(FB) decided to await the outcome of the discussions of that report before returning to these questions.8/

Coverage of the report

- 4. In order to improve the quality and coverage of the data in the present report, as well as to minimize the danger of double-counting of data identified in previous reports 9/, agencies were asked not to provide data on expenditures incurred by them against UNDP-administered funds, UNICEF and the United Nations Fund for Population Activities (UNFPA). Starting last year, these data were obtained from the funding organizations. In those cases where data on such expenditures were reported on, and identified as such, the data made available by the funding organization were substituted for those reported by agencies.
- As requested, the majority of the reporting agencies indicated in their replies the funding source according to the classification scheme adopted in 1980. One major exception was the United Nations Food and Agricultural Organization (FAO), which supplied data on its extra-budgetary expenditures in an aggregate form, i.e. broken down by country, but not by source of funding (except by regular budget and other sources of funding). Consequently, FAO data on extra-budgetary expenditures include those financed from United Nations system sources, multilateral sources other than United Nations system, bilateral sources and "self-supporting" contributions. It was decided, in consultation with FAO, to include all the extra-budgetary expenditures incurred by that Agency under "bilateral sources of funding" (table A.5), since the greater part of FAO extra-budgetary expenditures had been financed by bilateral funds in the past. However, expenditures incurred by FAO against the United Nations funding organizations mentioned in paragraph 4, were used in table A.3 and were consequently subtracted from table A.5. With respect to expenditures reported by the World Health Organization (WHO), these include support costs. Moreover, and as mentioned in last year's

report, $\frac{10}{}$ WHO reports to its governing bodies on a biennial basis. Therefore, and following the advice of WHO, the expenditures and contributions data presented for WHO represent exactly half of the total expenditures incurred, and contributions received, during the biennium 1980-1981. As regards the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO), it has for the first time reported technical co-operation expenditures against its regular budget, amounting to some \$5 million in 1981.

- II. 1981 REGULAR PROGRAMME AND EXTRA-BUDGETARY TECHNICAL CO-OPERATION EXPENDITURES FINANCED BY SOURCES OTHER THAN UNDP
- 6. The 1981 regular programme, non-UNDP-funded extra-budgetary, and UNDP-financed technical co-operation expenditures of each of the executing agencies are shown in table 1, together with a breakdown by sector. Twenty-two organizations and five regional commissions accounted for almost \$754 million funded from sources other than UNDP. In last year's report, corresponding expenditures of some \$494 million were reported by twenty organizations and five regional commissions. 11/ In order to make a comparison possible between the two years, several adjustments in the data must be made, taking account of the difference in coverage between the two years. With these adjustments made, estimated non-UNDP financed technical co-operation expenditures by twenty organizations and five regional commissions amounted to some \$550 million in 1981, reflecting an increase of some 11 per cent as against an increase of 29 per cent registered between 1979 and 1980.
- 7. The five larger agencies (United Nations, the International Labour Organisation (ILO), FAO, UNESCO and WHO) accounted for some 76 per cent of total expenditures in 1980 and 72 per cent in 1981. ILO's expenditures increased by some 30 per cent between the two years, and expenditures by UNESCO by almost 26 per cent, not counting the regular budget expenditures in 1981. 12/ The United Nations and FAO both increased their expenditures by some 12 per cent whereas WHO's extra-budgetary expenditures increased modestly, by only 2 per cent. However, the increase registered in WHO in regular budget expenditures between 1979 (the latest year preceding 1981 for which data are available) and 1981 almost doubled. WHO thus continues to have by far the largest non-UNDP financed technical co-operation programme, reaching a total of almost \$275 million in 1981.
- 8. In previous years, several of the smaller agencies have experienced significant rates of growth in their non-UNDP technical co-operation expenditures, although there are few, if any, generally valid trends. In 1981, the situation continued to be somewhat mixed. For example, the International Civil Aviation Organization's (ICAO) expenditures (which are largely of a "self-supporting" nature) continued to climb rapidly, from some \$15 million in 1980 to almost \$22 million in 1981. The United Nations Industrial Development Organization's (UNIDO) expenditures also continued to increase from \$18 million to \$21 million in 1981, an increase of 18 per cent.

At the other end of the scale, the expenditures by the International Maritime Organization (IMO), which registered very high growth rates in 1979 and 1980, declined by almost 13 per cent and the United Nations Centre for Transnational Corporations (UNCTC) whose expenditures have also increased in the past few years, declined by 25 per cent. Non-UNDP-financed extra-budgetary technical co-operation expenditures by the UNDP Office for Projects Execution (OPE), the United Nations Volunteers (UNV) and the United Nations Revolving Fund for Natural Resources Exploration (UNRFNRE) amounted to some \$30 million in 1981 as against expenditures of \$17 million by OPE and UNV alone in 1980.

(a) Sectoral distribution

- With the resumed reporting on expenditures against WHO's regular budget, 9. the health sector has regained its position as the most important sector among non-UNDP-financed technical co-operation expenditures of the United Nations system (see tables 1 and A.1). This sector accounted for some 35 per cent of total expenditures, down from 42 per cent in 1979 (when WHO last reported regular budget expenditures). Because UNFPA-funded expenditures by all executing agencies, including non-governmental organizations (NGO's), UNICEF and UNFPA itself have now been included in the analysis, population is the sector with the second highest expenditures, some \$127 million in 1981, or some 16 per cent of the total grant technical co-operation assistance. Next in importance is agriculture, forestry and fisheries with close to 16 per cent of the total, down from first to third most important sector. As mentioned last year, an additional reason for the relative importance of the population sector is that UNFPA has reported all its expenditures as belonging in the health sector, whereas in the past many agencies reported UNFPA-financed expenditures in other sectors (e.g. WHO under health, etc.).
- 10. With the rise in importance in the population sector registered last year, and the restoration of the health sector, the relative share of the three largest sectors account for more than two-thirds of total extra-budgetary expenditures. Natural resources accounted for some 7 per cent of all extra-budgetary grant expenditures, followed in importance by transport and communications (6 per cent), education, employment (both at 4 per cent) and industry (3 per cent).
- 11. As noted above, expenditures financed from regular budgets are concentrated in the health sector (some 76 per cent of total expenditures) followed by agriculture, forestry and fisheries (some 6 per cent), general development (4 per cent) and industry (2 per cent). Unilateral "self-supporting" expenditures which are financed by recipient countries themselves continue to be concentrated in the transport and communications sector with almost 44 per cent of all such expenditures (90 per cent of which were incurred by ICAO). Education remains the second most important sector for "self-supporting" expenditures 13/ with 15 per cent of the total. It is interesting to note that general development planning (4 per cent) has been replaced by employment (13 per cent) as the third most important sector for such expenditures, followed by industry (7 per cent).

(b) Regular programme expenditures

12. As noted above, this year's data are not comparable to last year's because of the inclusion of WHO and UNESCO expenditures for technical co-operation against regular budgets (see tables 1 and A.2). If data are adjusted to take this into account, regular budget expenditures increased by close to 22 per cent. The increase noted in WHO's regular budget between 1979 (the last year for which data were made available) and 1981, is rather spectacular: more than 96 per cent. Eight executing agencies reported that they had incurred no technical co-operation expenditures against their regular budgets in 1981 (the United Nations Conference on Trade and Development (UNCTAD), UNCTC, the Economic Commission for Europe (ECE), ICAO, IMO, the World Tourism Organization (WTO), OPE and the International Trade Centre (ITC)) as against seven in 1980. However, they are not the same organizations as in 1980; UNCTC and ECE did not incur such expenditures in 1981 whereas UNESCO did. On average, agency regular budget expenditures accounted for some 39 per cent of total extra-budgetary expenditures, which is an increase from 27 per cent reported for 1979, when reporting was as complete as this year. This is almost completely due to the increase in WHO's regular budget, since the second largest regular budget is that of FAO which increased by only 11 per cent (and constitutes 7 per cent of the total regular budget expenditures) against the doubling of WHO's budget between 1979 and 1981. Consequently, the downward trend in the share of regular budget expenditures in all extra-budgetary expenditures noted in previous reports has been reversed.

(c) Expenditures financed from extra-budgetary resources

- 13. The share of agency expenditures financed from bilateral resources in the total of their regular and extra-budgetary expenditures decreased from 60 per cent in 1980 to 41 per cent in 1981 (again due to the reporting of WHO's regular budget expenditures). However, in absolute terms there was an increase from \$265 million in 1980 to \$297 million in 1981 (or some 12 per cent). In terms of expenditures, FAO is by far the largest, with some \$113 million or about 38 per cent of all expenditures against bilateral sources in 1981. This is partly explained by the fact that all FAO extra-budgetary expenditures are reported as being in this category, with the exception of those financed by UNFPA, UNDP-administered funds and UNICEF (see paragraph 5). WHO has the second largest share with \$87 million, or 29 per cent (including support costs), followed by ILO (\$24 million) and UNESCO (\$14 million).
- 14. Following the pattern of 1980 expenditures, extra-budgetary expenditures incurred in 1981 financed from United Nations system sources constituted the second largest source of financing of agency expenditures, with \$213 million or 27 per cent of total grant-financed regular and extra-budgetary technical co-operation expenditures. Compared with 1980, such expenditures increased from \$116 million in 1980 to \$213 in 1981, or by some 84 per cent. This is partly due to the more complete reporting undertaken this year, with all UNFPA and UNDP-administered funds' expenditures accounted for, including those incurred by the funding entities themselves, as well as Governments and NGOs. This additional reporting accounts for some \$60 million of this increase. UNFPA and the United Nations were the agencies with highest expenditures in this category with \$55 and \$36 million respectively, followed by Governments, WHO and OPE.

- 15. Expenditures financed from multilateral sources other than the United Nations system increased only slightly from close to \$4 million reported for 1980 to \$4.7 million reported for 1981. By far the largest share of this amount was spent by UNESCO with \$1.9 million, or 41 per cent. As noted in last year's report, $\frac{14}{}$ agencies' changed reporting practices accounted for most of the decrease registered in this category betweeen 1979 and 1980.
- 16. As in previous years, agencies were also asked to report on "self-supporting" expenditures (see table A.8, last column). 15/ As mentioned above, FAO did not separately identify such expenditures and the expenditures of \$58 million now reported cannot therefore be compared to the \$39 million reported for 1980 (when WHO and FAO did not report such expenditures separately). As in 1980, most of these expenditures were incurred by oil-exporting developing countries, with Saudi Arabia accounting for almost 30 per cent (or \$17 million) of the total of \$58 million reported by agencies for 1981. ICAO is the agency with the highest amount of such expenditures with \$21 million (or 36 per cent) followed by WHO with \$13 million (or 22 per cent) and FAO with \$10 million (or 17 per cent). For reasons of space, the breakdown by agency of such expenditures is not included in the statistical annex but can be obtained from UNDP upon request.
 - III. EXTRA-BUDGETARY CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE SPECIALIZED AGENCIES AND IAEA
 FOR TECHNICAL CO-OPERATION ACTIVITIES IN 1981
- 17. For purposes of reporting contributions, agencies were requested to classify the contributions made to them by type, making a distinction between general contributions and unilateral "self-supporting" contributions, corresponding to that of expenditures. General contributions data are contained in table A.6, classifying the sources of contributions by country, by United Nations system sources, by non-United Nations system multilateral sources and by other miscellaneous sources. Table A.7 contains contributions for "self-supporting" activities.
- 18. Twenty-one organizations reported general extra-budgetary contributions of more than \$425 million received in 1981 as against seventeen organizations' receipts of \$283 million in 1980. The additional organizations are UNCHS, UPU and UNDP-non central funds. In addition, various contributions were reported for a number of additional organizations from different funding sources (mostly UNDP-administered funds), raising the total to some \$515 million. This figure cannot be compard to last year's since the reporting on expenditures flows within the United Nations system are now much more complete. The expenditures financed by UNFPA, UNICEF and UNDP-administered funds are now registered as contributions to the relevant organizations, since such expenditures are in fact paid up during, or shortly following, the year in which they were incurred.
- 19. Contributions by Governments directly to agencies for the purposes of technical co-operation were reported by twenty-one organizations as amounting to \$231 million in 1981 as against \$210 million in 1980. If an adjustment is made for the difference in organizational coverage, the increase was from \$210 to \$228 million, or an increase of almost 9 per cent. The three additional

reporting organizations are the Economic Commission for Western Asia (ECWA), the United Nations Centre for Human Settlements (UNCHS), the Universal Postal Union (UPU) and the International Telecommunication Union (ITU). Of the 1981 total of \$231 million, members of the Development Assistance Committee (DAC) of the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD) accounted for 91 per cent, or \$210 million. Adjusting for the different organizational coverage, DAC members' contributions registered an increase of some 13 per cent over last year's reported contributions. In contrast, members of the Organization of Petroleum-Exporting Countries (OPEC) contributed some \$10 million in 1981. Compared to the contributions made by OPEC members to the same agencies as in 1980, these contributions increased by almost \$4 million or two-thirds between 1980 and 1981.

- 20. An increase was also registered in the contributions received by agencies from NGOs, from \$7 million received in 1980 to close to \$12 million received in 1981: an increase of more than 70 per cent. This may be due to better reporting by WHO, which agency has now submitted audited complete accounts for 1981 (which was not the case for 1980) and whose contributions from NGOs increased from \$2.6 million in 1980 to \$6.7 million in 1981.
- 21. By far the largest increase was registered in contribution flows within the United Nations system, from a total of \$107 million in 1980, reported by seventeen organizations to a total of some \$264 million in 1981. However, and as mentioned above, this covers the quasi-totality of resource flows within the United Nations system (see especially footnotes e/ through n/ of table A.6) which were not covered in the same complete manner in previous years. The 1981 figure comparable to that for 1980 amounts to \$148 million, which in itself is a respectable increase of some 38 per cent between the two years. On the other hand, there was a sharp decrease in the contributions from non-United Nations system multilateral sources, which was more important than the decrease in expenditures financed from such sources. In spite of the additional number of reporting agencies, such contributions dropped from \$21 million in 1980 to less than \$8 million in 1981.
- 22. Continuing the practice introduced in reporting on 1979 data, table A.7 contains data on contributions received in support of "self-supporting" expenditures. Such contributions reached almost \$108 million in 1981, exceeding the figure reported for 1980 by more than \$43 million, and representing an increase of 68 per cent. However, ITU and WHO data were not included in last year's report, and adjusting for different coverage, the increase amounted to \$35 million or 54 per cent. OPEC members accounted for almost 70 per cent of such contributions, or \$75 million. Of the agencies, UNESCO has replaced ICAO as the recipient of the largest amount of "self-supporting" contributions with almost \$34 million, followed by FAO with close to \$30 million and ICAO is now in third place with close to \$16 million. ITU, UNIDO, and WHO also received significant amounts of such contributions in 1981.

IV. ASSISTANCE PROVIDED BY UNDP AND OTHER ORGANIZATIONS

23. For the purposes of comparison, table 1 includes summary data on UNDP project expenditures in 1981. These data conform with those in document DP/1982/6/Add.1 and Add.2, and are, as indicated in those documents, provisional.

- 24. Total UNDP project expenditures increased by some 16 per cent to almost \$732 million in 1981. Non-UNDP-financed technical co-operation expenditures consequently grew more slowly, by some 11 per cent between 1980 and 1981, if 1981 data are adjusted to compensate for the different organizational coverage. The majority of agencies continue to have the larger part of their technical co-operation activities financed by UNDP. The only exceptions to this rule are WHO, IAEA, the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO), UNCTC and ITC. All regional commissions except ECE also finance the greater share of their technical co-operation expenditures from sources other than UNDP.
- 25. Following the practice introduced in reporting on 1979 expenditures, data on World Bank and IDA technical co-operation expenditures have been incorporated into the report (see table A.8). These data reflect a proxy measure of technical co-operation expenditures financed under World Bank loans and IDA credits for the categories "training" and "consultants". Total disbursements under these categories reached almost \$517 million, up from \$464 million in 1980 (see DP/545/Corr.2). However, these data should be used as an order of magnitude only and should not be compared directly with UNDP and agency expenditures data. Apart from the difficulty of deciding what constitutes "technical co-operation", these data reflect disbursements against approved loans and credits rather than grants (as is the case with United Nations system expenditures).
- 26. Table A.8 also contains data on expenditures incurred by two non-technical co-operation bodies, namely UNICEF and WFP. UNICEF's expenditures decreased by some 14 per cent between 1980 and 1981. One cause may be that expenditures financed by UNFPA and the United Nations Capital Development Fund (UNCDF) previously reported in this column have now been reported in the respective columns for UNFPA and UNDP-administered funds in table A.8. Expenditures by WFP remained stable between the two years, and amounted to almost \$542 million in 1981. Expenditures financed by UNDP-administered funds have been separately identified in table A.8. Consequently, data contained in the column for agency extra-budgetary expenditures cover only those financed by United Nations system sources, non-United Nations system multilateral sources and bilateral sources, thereby constituting a summary of tables A.3-A.5 with the exception of UNFPA, UNDP-administered funds and UNICEF, whose expenditures have been subtracted from table A.3 and are presented separately in table A.8. Expenditures incurred against UNDP-administered funds \(\frac{16}{2} \) increased from \$34 million in 1980 to

\$70 million in 1981: an increase of 100 per cent. Part of this reported increase is undoubtedly the result of more complete reporting of expenditures by all entities (including the funds themselves).

- 27. The data on operational activities for development by the United Nations system contained in the country-by-country summaries in table A.8 of this report are to some extent incomplete and in many cases provisional. However, much of the double-counting present in previous reports has been eliminated which, together with the more comprehensive coverage of expenditures (including not only specialised agencies and IAEA, but also expenditures incurred by funding organizations themselves as well as Governments and NGOs) makes possible the presentation of a more accurate picture of the technical co-operation activities of the United Nations system than has been the case in the past. A large part of the increase from \$1.9 billion reported for 1980 to \$2.3 billion reported in 1981 in the grant assistance provided through the United Nations system can therefore be traced to better coverage.
- 28. A more complete picture of 1981 expenditures on operational activities for development of the United Nations system will be provided in the annual report on operational activities for development to be presented to the thirty-seventh session of the General Assembly by the Director-General for Development and International Economic Co-operation.
