Updated information DP/1984/71

- 1. In accordance with paragraph 17 of DP/1984/71 updated information through 31 May 1984 on the Trust Fund for countries afflicted by famine and malnutrition is provided below.
- 2. As of 31 May 1984, 81 projects in 48 countries had been approved or accepted in principle, entailing total budgets in the amount of \$24,955,400. A list of these projects is given in the Annex.
