EXTENSION OF THE THIRD COUNTRY PROGRAMME FOR GUATEMALA

Note by the Administrator

- 1. Submission of the fourth country programme for Guatemala has been postponed until the thirty-second session of the Governing Council, scheduled for June 1985. Consequently, the Government, in accordance with the revised country programming procedures for the third cycle, 1982-1986, as contained in document DP/518 and endorsed by the Council in its decision 81/15, has requested that its third country programme should be extended for one more year.
- 2. The Administrator wishes to inform the Council that he has approved this extension for a period of one year, until the end of 1984.
