Report of the Executive Director on allocations to projects in 1984

Summary

Pursuant to a decision made by the Governing Council at its seventeenth session, the Executive Director has been submitting annually a report on the approval of projects each year, in connection with his report on UNFPA activities for that year. This report contains a list of project allocations approved by UNFPA in 1984, by country and territory and region and by interregional and global category. Taking into account discussions about this document by various representatives to the Governing Council at the twenty-eighth session, this report also provides additional information about UNFPA projects and programmes, that is, cumulative expenditures for each project as of 31 December 1983, and the total anticipated cost of each project as of 31 December 1984. The latter figure represents only expenditures and allocations (cumulative and future) at this point in time, and not total Governing Council approvals. For many projects, particularly those that have been approved by the Governing Council, this figure will change from year to year. In this report, project titles have also been clarified and expanded in order to make them more meaningful and descriptive. The "DE" designation in the executing agency column means that the project is directly executed by the Government concerned. Also, where a nongovernmental organization is the executing agency, the name of the NGO is provided. This report is in two parts - DP/1985/30(Part I) and DP/1985/30(Part II).
