EXTENSION OF THE THIRD COUNTRY PROGRAMME FOR BANGLADESH

Note by the Administrator

- 1. The submission of the fourth country programme for Bangladesh has been postponed to the thirty-third session of the Governing Council which is scheduled to be held in June 1986. Consequently, the Government of Bangladesh, in accordance with the revised country programming procedures for the third cycle, 1982-1986, as contained in document DP/518 and endorsed by the Council in its decision 81/15, has requested that its third country programme be extended for one year.
- 2. The Administrator wishes to inform the Council that he has approved the extension of the country programme for Bangladesh for a period of one year beginning 1 July 1985.

^{*} The third country programme for Bangladesh covers the period July 1980 through June 1985 and was approved by the Governing Council at its twenty-eighth session (see documents DP/GC/BGD/R.3 and DP/GC/BGD/R.3/RECOMMENDATION).
