## Provisional agenda and organization of work of the thirty-third session

#### Addendum

- 1. Following the publication of document DP/1986/L.9, a number of adjustments in the proposed organization of work of the thirty-third session of the Governing Council were made in consultation with the President of the Council, H.E. Mr. Lloyd M.H. Barnett (Jamaica).
- 2. The high-level segment of the Council's session will now be shortened by one day and, thus, will take place from 9 to 12 June 1986. On 13 June 1986, the Council will then be scheduled to take up items 4(a) "Annual report of the Administrator for 1985" and 4(b) "Implementation of decisions adopted by the Governing Council at previous sessions" which had previously been scheduled for consideration on 24 June. This rearrangement should enable the Council to complete the thirty-third session by Saturday, 28 June 1986, at the latest.
- 3. Furthermore, the Council's Drafting Group will begin its activities on Wednesday, 18 June 1986 instead of on Monday, 16 June 1986. This change is made for two reasons: to avoid an overlap of meetings of the Drafting Group with those of the Committee of the Whole scheduled for 16 and 17 June 1986 and to release conference services which can be used instead on Saturday, 7 June 1986 and Saturday, 28 June 1986 for two meetings each of the Committee of the Whole and the Council, respectively, without additional financial cost which would have to be borne by UNDP.

- 4. A revised tentative schedule of work of the Governing Council and the Committee of the Whole reflecting these adjustments is contained in the annex to this addendum.
- 5. In the light of the financial crisis of the United Nations, the Administrator was advised by the Department of Conference Services that the following measures will be required to help limit documentation and the associated costs:
- (a) Summary records of plenary meetings of the Governing Council will be circulated upon their completion in English or French original - depending on the language of the team of precis-writers assigned to a particular meeting and the other language versions will be circulated later as resources will allow;
- (b) Efforts should be made to reduce in-session documentation as much as possible.
