EXTENSION OF THE THIRD COUNTRY PROGRAMME FOR MALDIVES*

Note by the Administrator

- 1. The third country programme for Maldives for the period 1982-1986 will be completed at the end of 1986. The fourth country programme was scheduled for *submission to the Governing Council at its thirty-third session. The Government, however, wishes to synchronize the fourth country programme as much as possible with the new national development plan, which will commence at the beginning of 1988. In accordance with the revised country programme procedures contained in document DP/518 and Corr.l and Add. 1, endorsed by the Council in its decision 81/15, the Government has requested that its third country programme be extended for one year, through 1987. The objectives of this country programme as approved by the Governing Council remain unchanged. The submission of the fourth country programme has been postponed to the thirty-fifth session of the Governing Council, to be held in 1988.
- 2. The Administrator wishes to inform the Council that he has approved the extension of the country programme for Maldives for a period of one year, through 1987.
