## Draft decision

Joint Inspection Unit

The Governing Council,

I

Having considered the note of the Administrator on the Reports of the Joint Inspection Unit for 1986 (DP/1987/13 and Corr.1),

Takes note of the information provided in the note of the Administrator with respect to the Reports of the Joint Inspection Unit entitled "Problems of storage and its costs in organizations of the United Nations system" (A/41/806 and Corr. 1), and "Co-operation between the United Nations and the League of Arab States" (A/41/615) and the comments of the Secretary-General thereon (A/41/615/Add.1);

Having considered the Report of the Joint Inspection Unit entitled "Technical co-operation activities of the International Telecommunication Union",

<u>Reaffirms</u> its decision 86/25 of 27 June 1986 concerning additional support cost reimbursement to the International Telecommunication Union;

<u>Having considered</u> the Report of the Joint Inspection Unit entitled "Field representation of organizations of the United Nations system: structure and co-ordination" (A/41/242) and comments of the ACC thereon (A/42/290),

1. Reaffirms its decision 85/3 of 28 June 1985 on co-ordination;

2. <u>Requests</u> the Administrator to co-operate, as required, in the systematic review of all field offices of the organization of the United Nations system under the Secretary-General's authority, referred to in paragraph 6 of A/42/290;

3. <u>Takes note</u> of recommendations 1 and 2 of the JIU report addressed to the General Assembly and in expressing its support of these recommendations urges the General Assembly to adopt a resolution appealing to Governments and urging organizations of the United Nations system to adopt all measures required to achieve the full implementation of these recommendations;

4. Takes note of recommendation 3 of the JIU report and notes the proposal contained in paragraph 23 of the ACC comments (A/42/290) as a means of broadening the UNDP roster for the post of resident representative;

Having considered the report of the Joint Inspection Unit entitled "Technical co-operation between UNDP and the regional economic commissions: Economic Commission for Africa (ECA) (A/42/110) and the comments of the Secretary-General thereon (A/42/110/Add.1),
