EXTENSION OF THE THIRD COUNTRY PROGRAMME FOR BAHRAIN

Note by the Administrator

1. The third country programme for Bahrain (DP/CP/BAH/3) for the period 1982-1986, which was approved by the Governing Council at its special meeting in May 1982, expired on 31 December 1986.
2. The Government has requested the Administrator to extend the country programme by one year. The Government has established a special committee to carry out a study on development strategies, objectives and priorities over the next five to ten years. The committee's report has recently been completed and is now being reviewed by the Government. Clear guidelines for technical co-operation will also emerge from the review, on the basis of which the fourth country programme will be formulated.
3. The fourth country programme will be submitted for review and approval to the Governing Council in February 1988.
4. The Administrator wishes to inform the Council that he has approved the extension of the third country programme for Bahrain for a period of one year, to the end of 1987.
