EXTENSION OF THE FIRST COUNTRY PROGRAMME FOR BERMUDA

Note by the Administrator

1. The first country programme for Bermuda (DP/CP/BER/1) for the period 1982-1986, which was approved by the Governing Council at its Special Meeting in May 1982, expired on 31 December 1986. Negotiations are taking place with the Government regarding the formulation of a new country programme for the fourth cycle on the basis of the obligations stipulated in Governing Council decision 85/16. Pending the resolution of this issue, the Government has requested that the third cycle programme be extended.
2. The Administrator wishes to inform the Council that he has approved the extension of the first country programme for Bermuda for a period of one year, through 1987.
