EXTENSION OF THE FIRST COUNTRY PROGRAMME FOR BERMUDA

Note by the Administrator

- 1. The first country programme for Bermuda (DP/CP/BER/1) for the period 1982-1986, which was approved by the Governing Council at its Special Meeting in May 1982, expired on 31 December 1986. Negotiations are taking place with the Government regarding the formulation of a new country programme for the fourth cycle on the basis of the obligations stipulated in Governing Council decision 85/16. Pending the resolution of this issue, the Government has requested that the third cycle programme be extended.
- 2. The Administrator wishes to inform the Council that he has approved the extension of the first country programme for Bermuda for a period of one year, through 1987.
