EXTENSION OF THE FOURTH COUNTRY PROGRAMME FOR KENYA\*

## Note by the Administrator

- 1. The fourth country programme for Kenya (DP/GC/KEN/R.4) expired on 31 December 1986. Although there exists a National Development Plan for the period 1984-1988 and a Government Sessional Paper No. 1 (1986): "Economic Management for Renewed Growth", the Government has expressed the wish to postpone the preparation of the new country programme.
- 2. Three factors constitute the justification for the extension of the ongoing fourth country programme for Kenya: (a) the Kenya Government Budget Rationalization Programme; (b) a new thematic approach for the country programme exercise; and (c) the clear programming of two important sectors in the formulation of the fourth country programme: agriculture and industry.
- 3. Accordingly, the Government of Kenya has requested that its third country programme be extended for 18 months, until June 1988. The objectives of the country programme as approved by the Council remain unchanged.
- 4. The fourth country programme will be submitted for review and approval to the Council in June 1988.
- 5. The Council is requested to approve the extension of the fourth country programme for Kenya for a period of 18 months, until June 1988.
