Corrigendum

Paragraph 64

Replace paragraph 64 with the following text:

64. To date, little has been done to develop and exploit mineral resources in Pakistan. The exploitation of mineral resources may be of interest especially for provinces and areas that are relatively less developed. UNDP assistance will concentrate on pre-investment activities for the evaluation of mineral deposits in two areas. In one area, UNDP will finance both the exploration and economic evaluation of sulphur, lead and zinc deposits, whereas, in the other, UNDP will participate only in general exploration work.
