EXTENSION OF THE SECOND COUNTRY PROGRAMME FOR SAO TOME AND PRINCIPE

Note by the Administrator

1. The second country programme for Sao Tome and Principe (DP/CP/STP/2), which was approved by the Governing Council in February 1983, expired on 31 December 1986.

2. The Government has requested the Administrator to extend the second country programme for one more year, to the end of 1987, in order to complete the ongoing review of the country programming exercise, which is being conducted jointly by the Government and the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) in order to determine how UNDP can best respond to the priorities identified by the follow-up round-table sectoral consultations of May 1986 and the Five-Year Plan.

3. The third country programme for Sao Tome and Principe will be submitted to the Council for approval in February 1988.

4. The Administrator wishes to inform the Council that he has approved the extension of the second country programme for Sao Tome and Principe for a period of one year until the end of 1987.
