EXTENSION OF THE THIRD COUNTRY PROGRAMME FOR TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

## Note by the Administrator

- 1. The third country programme for Trinidad and Tobago for the period 1983-1986, which was approved by the Governing Council at its thirtieth session in June 1983, expired on 31 December 1986. Although some preliminary work on the fourth country programme was carried out in 1986, the Government subsequently decided to await the results of elections scheduled in December 1986 before finalizing the programme. The new Government, which assumed office in January 1987, has indicated its intention to submit the fourth country programme to the Governing Council at its June 1988 session.
- 2. The Administrator wishes to inform the Council that he has approved the extension of the third country programme for Trinidad and Tobago for a period of one year, through 1987.
