EXTENSION OF THE SECOND COUNTRY PROGRAMME FOR UGANDA

Note by the Administrator

1. The second country programme for Uganda (DP/CP/UGA/2), which was approved by the Governing Council at its thirtieth session (June 1983), expired on 31 December 1986. The Government is currently in the process of finalizing the Investment Plan known as the Appropriate Plan for Rehabilitation and Development (1985/86-1989/90), which will articulate financial, fiscal and monetary policies and determine the type of projects to be supported by internal and external sources including the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP).

2. Pending the finalization and adoption of the Investment Plan, the Government of Uganda has requested extension of the second country programme by one year until the end of 1987. The objectives of the second country programme remain valid.

3. The third country programme will be submitted for review and approval to the Council in February 1988.

4. The Administrator wishes to inform the Council that he has approved the extension of the second country programme for Uganda for a period of one year, to the end of 1987.
