COUNTRY AND INTERCOUNTRY PROGRAMMES AND PROJECTS

EXTENSION OF THE THIRD COUNTRY PROGRAMME FOR BURKINA FASO*

Note by the Administrator

1. The third country programme for Burkina Faso (DP/CP/UPV/3) expired on 31 December 1986. Although there exists a National Development Plan approved officially on 4 August 1986, the Government has expressed the wish to postpone the preparation of the new country programme until the Public Investment Programme is finalized and the Round Table process gets under way. These would obviously have important implications on and influence the content of the fourth cycle programme.
2. Accordingly, the Government of Burkina Faso has requested that its third country programme be extended for 18 months, until June 1988. The objectives of the country programme as approved by the Council remain unchanged.
3. The fourth country programme will be submitted for review and approval to the Council in June 1988.
4. The Council is asked to approve the extension of the third country programme for Burkina Faso for a period of 18 months, until June 1988.

* The third country programme for Burkina Faso, for the period 1983-1986, was approved by the Governing Council at its special session of February 1983.
