EXTENSION OF THE THIRD COUNTRY PROGRAMME FOR YEMEN

Note by the Administrator

- 1. The third country programme for Yemen (1983-1986) expired on 31 December 1986. The Government has requested the Administrator to extend the country programme by one year.
- 2. The new Third Five-Year Plan (1987-1991), which was expected to be launched in January 1987, has yet to be finalized. The fourth country programme (1987-1991), based on the Third Plan, is currently under preparation. Serious attempts are being made to present a well-prepared document which will concentrate UNDP inputs in selected high-priority areas.
- 3. The fourth country programme will be presented for review and approval to the Council in February 1988.
- 4. The Administrator wishes to inform the Council that he has approved the extension of the third country programme for Yemen by one year, until the end of 1987.
