<u>Summary financial information on all trust funds</u> established by the Administrator since 1981

SUMMARY

The present report is submitted to the Governing Council in accordance with its decisions 85/37 of 29 June 1985 and 89/60 of 30 June 1989 by which it requested the Administrator to provide summary financial information on all trust funds established by him since 1981. INTRODUCTION

1. Regulation 5.1 of the Financial Regulations of the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP), adopted by the Governing Council in its decision 81/28 of 30 June 1981, gives the Administrator the authority to establish trust funds for specified purposes consistent with the policies, aims and activities of the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP).

2. Each year a detailed report is made to the Governing Council of all trust funds established by the Administrator during the previous calendar year. That report provides a brief narrative for each fund, covering its purpose and scope, and a table indicating donors, recipients, expected duration, and executing agencies, as well as the amount of contribution and the arrangements for support costs. Document DP/1990/68 covers the trust funds established by the Administrator in 1989.

3. The present report provides summary financial information on the trust funds established by the Administrator since 1981, as requested by the Governing Council in its decision 89/60 of 30 June 1989. Pursuant to that decision, a background note giving details of the scope and nature of the activities of each trust fund will be made available to the Council.

I. TRUST FUNDS ESTABLISHED BY THE UNITED NATIONS DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME

4. From the initial three funds established in 1982, the Programme has expanded rapidly to cover 50 trust funds in operation by the end of 1989. Programme delivery moved from \$326,968 in 1982 to \$19,168,554 in 1989. This growth is summarized as follows:

5. Section A of the annex to the present report provides a summary of the income and expenditure of the individual trust funds, together with the balance of unexpended resources at 31 December 1989. Details of the income and expenditure of individual sub-trust funds are included in the audited financial statements submitted to the Governing Council each year.

II. SUB-TRUST FUNDS ESTABLISHED ON BEHALF OF TRUST FUNDS

A. United Nations Capital Development Fund

6. At the end of 1989, there were 13 sub-trust funds in operation under the United Nations Capital Development Fund (UNCDF). Total income received to 1989 in respect of these sub-trust funds amounted to \$23,893,678 and expenditure to \$24,122,634 with an additional \$15,237 transferred to the main fund, leaving an accumulated deficit of \$244,193 at 31 December 1989.

B. United Nations Fund for Science and Technology for Development

7. At the end of 1989, there were 12 sub-trust funds in operation under the United Nations Fund for Science and Technology for Development (UNFSTD). Total income received to 1989 in respect of these sub-trust funds amounted to \$25,379,618 and expenditure to \$25,173,886, leaving an unexpended balance of \$205,732 at 31 December 1989.

C. United Nations Sudano-Sahelian Office

8. At the end of 1989 there were 20 sub-trust funds in operation under the United Nations Sudano-Sahelian Office (UNSO). Total income received to 1989 in respect of these sub-trust funds amounted to \$27,755,101 and expenditure to \$24,670,543 with \$120,000 transferred to the main fund, leaving an unexpended balance of \$2,964,558 at 31 December 1989.

D. United Nations Volunteer programme

9. At the end of 1989 there were five sub-trust funds in operation under the United Nations Volunteer programme (UNV). Total income received to 1989 in respect of these sub-trust funds amounted to \$3,628,906 and expenditure to \$185,046, leaving an unexpended balance of \$3,443,860 at 31 December 1989.

E. United Nations Development Fund for Women

10. At the end of 1989 there were five sub-trust funds in operation under the United Nations Development Fund for Women (UNIFEM). Total income received to 1989 in respect of these sub-trust funds amounted to \$5,420,504 and expenditure to \$1,522,318 with \$41,035 transferred to the main fund, leaving an unexpended balance of \$3,857,151 at 31 December 1989.
