# EXTENSION OF THE FOURTH COUNTRY PROGRAMME FOR VENEZUELA

## Note by the Administrator

- 1. The fourth country programme for Venezuela (DP/CP/VEN/4) was approved by the Governing Council in June 1987 for the period 1987-1989, in line with the Government's Development Plan and in order to coincide with the term of office of the Government.
- 2. The new Government, elected in December 1988, has requested an extension of the programme for one year (January-December 1990).
- 3. The objectives of the programme as approved remain valid. The Government has included one new objective "to support programmes oriented towards the groups of extreme vulnerability", which responds to the priorities identified in the Development Plan.
- 4. In view of the above, the Administrator wishes to inform the Council that he has approved the extension of the fourth country programme for Venezuela for a period of one year, through 1990.
