(a) The relationship between UNDP-assisted projects and reported investment commitment is classified as follows: CATEGORY A relates to reported commitments for which the UNDP-assisted projects carried out micro-type pre-investment studies such as identification, pre-feasibility and feasibility studies which collect, analyse and present economic, financial, technical, institutional and social data in a form that would facilitate capital investment decisions; preparatory activities such as engineering studies, final design, site preparation, etc., are also included in this category when they are carried out prior to the investment stage. CATEGORY B relates to commitments resulting from macro-type studies such as general area or regional planning studies, sector development studies, natural resources surveys, master plans, etc., all of which broadly identify the need for follow-up investment. CATEGORY C commitments stem from technical co-operation activities which support capital investment projects, such as assistance in the execution and supervision of investment projects, training of technical and managerial staff, etc. The purpose of these projects is to facilitate, implement or otherwise streamline the capital investment project. Note also that the data refer to commitments and not actual investment.

(b) The data contained in this and the following table (table 10) are rough estimates for 1990 because (i) they may involve double-counting of previous years' commitments; (ii) they may involve counting of commitments identified for 1991; and (iii) because of incomplete data. Final data for 1989 will be available in the Investment Commitment Report for 1990.

e/ This column gives fellowships placed in a specific country by project financed from sources in a/. It also includes participants in seminars and training courses. Note that the total of this column is greater than that of the corresponding column of table 12. Table 13 makes provision for the fact that some fellowships required study in more than one country.

f/ This column gives the value of equipment ordered from specific countries.

g/ The data in this column represents the value of subcontracts awarded to specific countries. It includes new subcontracts awarded in 1990 as well as net additions to sub-contracts awarded in 1989.

h/ On 22 May 1990, the Democratic Yemen and Yemen merged to form a single State. Since that date they have been represented as one Member of the United Nations with the name "Yemen". The data are reported separately here since the study was completed prior to the merger.

i/ Data on individual country not readily available.

j/ Through the accession of the German Democratic Republic to the Federal Republic of Germany with effect from 3 October 1990, the two German States have united to form one sovereign State; the data in table 13 have been combined.
