### EXTENSION OF THE FOURTH COUNTRY PROGRAMME FOR MONGOLIA

# Note by the Administrator

- 1. The fourth country programme for Mongolia was approved at the thirty-third session of the Governing Council (June 1986) for the programme period January 1987 to December 1991. The Government has now commenced a period of major political and economic reforms and has consequently postponed the national planning exercise in order to assimilate the implications of the reform. The Government wishes the national development plan to form the basis for the new country programme and has, therefore, requested that the current country programme be extended for one year. The themes of the fourth country programme, namely agriculture, industry, natural resources, international trade, and science and technology continue to remain valid for the period of the programme extension.
- 2. The Administrator wishes to inform the Council that he has approved the extension of the fourth country programme for Mongolia for a period of one year beginning 1 January 1991.
