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The meeting was called to order at 4 p.m.

STANDING COMMITTEE FOR PROGRAMME MATTERS (continued) (DP/1991/L.4)

1. The PRESIDENT explained that it was necessary to proceed immediately to informal consultations on the draft decision on the Standing Committee for Programme Matters.

The meeting was suspended at 4.05 p.m. and resumed at 5.15 p.m.

2. Mr. JASINSKI (Poland), speaking as Vice-President of the Governing Council and coordinator of the relevant informal consultations, introduced the draft decision entitled "Standing Committee for Programme Matters" (DP/1991/L.4), which dealt with the substantive and procedural aspects of the Standing Committee.

3. The PRESIDENT said that, because of the financial implications of the draft decision just introduced, it had to be reviewed by the Budgetary and Finance Committee before the Council could take a decision on it. He therefore proposed that the Budgetary and Finance Committee should be convened for the purpose under the chairmanship of Mr. Kramer (Canada).

4. It was so decided.
