STATUS OF FINANCIAL IMPLEMENTATION OF GOVERNING COUNCIL-APPROVED COUNTRY PROGRAMMES AND PROJECTS

Report of the Executive Director

SUMMARY

This report of the Executive Director on the status of financial implementation of Governing Council-approved UNFPA country programmes and projects is prepared in response to decision 84/21 III, paragraph 2, which was approved by the Governing Council at its thirty-first session. It contains details on expenditures to these programmes and projects by year as well as by region and country, showing the amounts still to be allocated under Governing Council approvals. It also assesses the level of programme implementation by applying the concept of multi-year resource delivery rate as introduced in document DP/1989/34 submitted to the thirty-sixth session of the Council. This document is submitted to the Council for its information.

I. INTRODUCTION

- 1. At its thirtieth session (1983), the Governing Council, in decision 83/17 I, paragraph 19, requested the Executive Director to submit to the Council a report on its approvals by country, giving the period covered, total commitments, expenditures of past years and current allocations. In compliance with this request, the Executive Director provided the required information to the Council at its thirty-first session, in a document entitled "Report of the Executive Director on the Status of Financial Implementation of Governing Council-Approved UNFPA Country Programmes and Projects" (DP/1984/32).
- 2. At its thirty-first session, the Council expressed its appreciation for the report provided by the Executive Director and requested, in decision 84/21 III, paragraph 2, that similar reports be provided in future years. The Executive Director herewith presents the eighth update of this information, which should be read in conjunction with the Work Plan for 1993-1996 and request for approval authority (DP/1992/26), also being submitted to the Governing Council at its thirty-ninth session.
- 3. In view of the concern of the Council about the timeliness of allocations that are based upon Council approval, this report is structured according to the date of approval by the Council rather than according to geographical or other country groupings. Thus, information is provided on: (a) those programmes and projects that were completed in 1991 and those that were ongoing in January 1992; and (b) those that are being submitted to the present session.
- 4. To give a more accurate picture of the progress of UNFPA activities, estimated expenditures for 1991 have been used rather than allocations for that year.
- 5. This report provides information on the "resource delivery rate" of programmes completed in 1991. The programme resource delivery rate, which was defined in document DP/1989/34, is expressed as the total expenditure for a programme, divided by the total amount approved by the Governing Council for that programme. Tables include the resource delivery rate for each completed programme and the current expenditure rate for ongoing programmes. The current expenditure rate is the total expenditure accumulated up to and including 1991 divided by the total amount approved. It applies to ongoing programmes only. When a programme completes its cycle, the current expenditure rate becomes the resource delivery rate.
- 6. In terms of the format of tables, it is important to note the following: the starting date of a programme is the one approved by the Governing Council; the end of a programme is either (a) the year when all projects were completed, or (b) the year when a subsequent programme began. There cannot be two contemporaneous programmes within one country. For programmes starting and/or ending in the middle of a year, the yearly expenditures have been prorated.
- 7. In compliance with the Governing Council request, and because the Fund has sought and obtained assistance from multi-bilateral sources to supplement its regular budget, the presentation of the data reflects these additional contributions. Tables A.1 to A.6 show the expenditures for country programmes approved by the Governing Council, year by year.

- 8. In those tables, the total amount of funds approved by the Governing Council is shown in column (1). This amount includes funds programmed from UNFPA regular resources and funds from other resources. The latter are a combination of additional UNFPA regular resources and other resources, including multi-bilateral resources. Column (2) shows the amount of regular funds programmed. Column (3) shows all the funds spent (and therefore includes the expenditures of regular funds and of other resources, including multi-bilateral funds). Column (4) shows all regular funds spent.
- 9. The resource delivery rates of completed programmes and the current rate of expenditure of ongoing programmes appear in column (5) of tables A.1. to A.6. The calculations of the rates take into account all funds. Column (6) of the tables for completed programmes shows the balance between the amount of regular funds that have been programmed and the amount of regular funds that have been expended. In the case of ongoing programmes, column (6) shows the amounts that have been approved but not yet spent and thus reflects the Fund's balance of commitment to the specific countries in question. The total UNFPA balance of commitments to country programmes is reflected in table C, which is also broken down by region. Table B lists the submissions to the thirty-ninth session of the Council.

II. COUNTRY PROGRAMMES APPROVED BY THE COUNCIL AT ITS THIRTY-THIRD THROUGH THIRTY-EIGHTH SESSIONS

10. At its thirty-third session in 1986 (table A.1), the Governing Council approved seven country programmes, two of which are still ongoing and three of which (Mozambique, Egypt and Jordan) ended in 1991. New programmes for these three countries are being submitted for approval to the upcoming session of the Governing Council (table B).

- 11. At its thirty-fourth session (1987), the Governing Council approved 31 country programmes in sub-Saharan Africa, Arab States and Europe, Asia and the Pacific, and Latin America and the Caribbean. Of these, 3 were completed in 1990 and 20 in 1991 while 8 are still ongoing. The expenditures for these programmes are contained in table A.2. For the countries that have completed their programmes, new programmes have either been approved by the Council in 1991 (table A.6) or are being submitted for approval by the Council at its thirty-ninth session (table B). For ongoing programmes, the balance of commitments of regular funds totals \$0.8 million. It should be noted that when the balance of commitments is negative (column (6)), it is recorded as zero. It should also be noted that for completed programmes, a negative balance of "programmed regular funds" (column (2)) less "regular funds" spent (column (4)) does not necessarily indicate an over-expenditure, since UNFPA is authorized by the Council to use regular funds to make up the difference between the amount of funds programmed from regular resources and the total amount approved for the programme.
- 12. At its thirty-fifth session (1988), the Governing Council approved 16 country programmes in sub-Saharan Africa, Arab States and Europe, Asia and the Pacific and Latin America and the Caribbean, 6 of which were completed in 1991 and 9 of which are still ongoing. The expenditures for these programmes are contained in table A.3. For the countries that have completed their programmes, new programmes are being submitted to the Governing Council at its thirty-ninth session and are shown in table B.

At its thirty-sixth session (1989), the Governing Council approved 13 country programmes in sub-Saharan Africa, Arab States and Europe, Asia and the Pacific, and Latin America and the Caribbean totalling \$146.1 million. The expenditures for these programmes are all ongoing and are contained in table A.4.

III. SUBMISSIONS OF PROPOSED COUNTRY PROGRAMMES TO THE COUNCIL AT ITS THIRTY-NINTH SESSION

16. UNFPA is submitting to the thirty-ninth session of the Council for its consideration and approval 30 country programmes in sub-Saharan Africa, Arab States and Europe, Asia and the Pacific and Latin

American and the Caribbean, plus a subregional programme for the South Pacific. Twenty-five of these programmes have an intended duration of five years. These country programmes are presented in table B. The total amount for these 31 programmes is \$318.6 million, (i.e., \$224.1 million from programmed regular funds and \$94.5 million from other resources including multi-bilateral resources).
