Annual financial review, 1991

Summary

In this report, the Executive Director provides, as requested by the Governing Council, a financial review of the activities financed by UNFPA and of its trust funds in 1991. The report shows the Fund's financial position and accounts as at the end of 1991. Annual data on income and expenditures are included for 1989, 1990 and 1991. The annexes include the unaudited financial statements for the year ended 31 December 1991.

Introduction

- 1. In response to decisions 85/20 II and 87/31, paragraph 9, adopted by the Governing Council at its thirty-second and thirty-fourth sessions, respectively, the Executive Director presents in this report a review of the financial situation of the United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA) for 1991. As in prior years, the information and financial data available for the preparation of this report include the unaudited financial statements of the Fund (Annexes I and II). Pursuant to UNFPA financial regulation 16.3, the financial statements for the biennium 1990-1991 will be submitted to the Board of External Auditors on or before 30 April 1992 and transmitted by the Chairman of the Board to the President of the General Assembly in June 1992. It is estimated that the unaudited financial statements and preliminary data presented in this report will not vary substantially from the audited financial statements so as to alter the analysis and conclusions of this presentation in any significant manner.
- 2. This document includes the actual data available for 1989, 1990 and 1991. Audited data for 1989 was extracted from the UNFPA year-end audited financial statements as contained in document A/45/5/Add.7. For the reasons noted in documents DP/1991/39 and DP/1992/33 concerning Audit Reports, the United Nations Board of Auditors qualified its audit opinion on the financial statements of UNFPA for the year ended 31 December 1989. The 1991 figures provided herein include data obtained from the 1991 unaudited annual accounts of the executing agencies with regard to the status of funds allocated to them and expended in the execution of UNFPA projects during 1991. Should any changes be reported in the audited accounts of any of the executing agencies, they will be reported by the Executive Director to the Governing Council at its next (fortieth) session in the audited statements and audit reports. A financial summary containing information on budgetary trends is provided in Annex IX. These data are provided as requested by the Governing Council at its thirty-second and thirty-fourth sessions.

I. ANNUAL REVIEW OF THE FUND'S FINANCIAL SITUATION

A. Income and expenditure

3. Table 1 provides a summary of 1991 pledges and payments by donors as compared to 1989 and 1990. Annex III shows in detail the status of the voluntary contributions pledged by all donors as at 31 December 1991. The outstanding cumulative balance of unpaid pledges as at 31 December 1991 was \$1.6 million, as follows:

- 4. Table 2 shows a comparison of income and expenditures for 1989, 1990 and 1991. Total income in 1991 amounted to \$224.0 million and total expenditures to \$229.1 million. This resulted in an excess of expenditure over income of \$5.1 million. Annual income includes pledges from Governments, investment income and miscellaneous income but excludes contributions to trust funds. In accordance with UNFPA financial rule 116.1(a), income was recorded on an accrual basis. As required by financial rule 104.1, all pledges were recorded in United States dollars, converted at the United Nations operational rate of exchange in effect on the date of the pledge and, if paid, converted at the rate of exchange prevailing on the date of the payment.
- 5. Total income in 1991 increased by \$11.6 million or 5.5 per cent over the 1990 income of \$212.4 million and by \$38.8 million or 20.9 per cent over the 1989 income of \$185.2 million. Total contributions pledged by 96 Governments in 1991 reached \$220.7 million, an increase of \$14.9 million in dollar terms or 7.2 per cent over the \$205.8 million pledged in 1990. Interest income amounted to \$3.7 million or 1.6 per cent of total income. Other miscellaneous income and adjustments, including revaluation of currencies and gains/losses on currency exchange, totalled (minus) -\$0.4 million (table 2). The rather modest 5.5 per cent increase in income in 1991 was, in large part, the result of the appreciation of the United States dollar during the course of the year. This had an impact on the value of contributions paid in non- U.S. dollar denominated currencies, which accounted for the bulk of contributions (see table 1).

B. Programme expenditures and operational costs

- 6. As shown in table 2, total expenditures in 1991 were \$229.1 million, an increase of \$7.8 million or 3.5 per cent compared to 1990 expenditures and an increase of \$25.6 million or 12.6 per cent compared to 1989 expenditures. In table 3, programme expenditures and operational costs (composed of the administrative and programme support services (APSS) budget expenditures and agency support costs) are compared for 1989, 1990 and 1991 as a percentage of total expenditures. Programme expenditures in 1991, which amounted to \$171.8 million, constituted 75.0 per cent of the total expenditures, compared to 76.3 per cent in 1990 and 77.4 per cent in 1989. Operational cost expenditures in 1991 totalled \$57.3 million or 25.0 per cent of total expenditures. The total APSS budget expenditure in 1991, comprising the headquarters administrative budget and total field office costs, amounted to \$42.3 million or 18.5 per cent of total expenditures compared to \$37.8 million or 17.1 of total expenditures in 1990 and \$32.1 million or 15.8 per cent of total expenditures in 1989.
- 7. The APSS field office expenditure in 1991, which includes all field office costs as in 1990, totalled \$18.7 million. This compares to all field office costs of \$15.6 million in 1990 and \$11.6 million in 1989. Agency support costs in 1991 totalled \$15.0 million, or 6.5 per cent of total expenditure (compared to \$14.6 million or 6.6 per cent of total expenditure in 1990 and \$14.0 million or 6.9 per cent of total expenditure in 1989). In 1991, as in 1990 and 1989, the agency support costs comprised the reimbursement to United Nations executing agencies for support services, payment of overhead charges to non-governmental organizations (NGOs) and reimbursement to UNFPA for support and procurement services provided for government-executed projects.

- 8. As shown in table 4, in 1991 the United Nations executing agencies, including the regional commissions, executed projects amounting to \$91.4 million compared to \$90.5 million in 1990 and \$88.3 million in 1989. Governments, with the assistance of UNFPA field offices, executed \$30.9 million in 1991, compared to \$33.3 million in 1990 and \$22.4 million in 1989. Expenditures for government-executed projects did not include \$6.9 million of advances to Governments, which at year-end were held by Governments and not reported as expenditure (see also Annex II). UNFPA-executed projects totalled \$29.5 million in 1991, compared to \$25.6 million in 1990 and \$26.9 million in 1989, and included procurement assistance in respect to Governments' projects amounting to \$13.4 million in 1991. Programme expenditures for projects executed by NGOs and other agencies, such as intergovernmental institutions and academic and research centres, were \$20.0 million in 1991, compared to \$19.5 million in 1990 and \$19.8 million in 1989. Expenditures for NGO-executed projects did not include \$2.3 million for advances made in 1991.
- 9. Table 4 also shows the percentage breakdown of programme expenditures by executing agency for 1989, 1990 and 1991. Projects executed by the United Nations and its specialized agencies and regional commissions amounted to \$91.4 million or 53.2 per cent of programme expenditures of \$171.8 million in 1991. Governments executed \$30.9 million or 18.0 per cent of programme expenditures in 1991. NGOs and other agencies, including intergovernmental institutions, executed \$20.0 million or 11.6 per cent of programme expenditures in 1991. Annex IV shows 1991 expenditures by executing agency and by major expenditure component of the project budgets. Annex VII shows programme expenditures by country for 1989, 1990 and 1991.

C. Status of unexpended balance of general resources

10. On 1 January 1991, the balance of available funds for programming showed a deficit of \$0.4 million. As shown in table 5, after adding an excess of expenditure over income of \$5.1 million, the unexpended balance of general resources available for programming resulted in a deficit of \$5.5 million as at 31 December 1991 (see also Annex II).

D. Status of the operational reserve

11. The operational reserve was established by the Governing Council in January 1973 at the \$20 million level to guarantee the financial viability and integrity of the UNFPA programme. In accordance with Governing Council decision 89/49, paragraph 16, during 1991 UNFPA maintained a fully funded operational reserve at the level of \$45.0 million (see Annex II). There were no additions to the operational reserve in 1991. At its thirty-eighth session, the Governing Council in decision 91/36 decided that the level of the operational reserve should be set at 20 per cent of general resources income for each year of the UNFPA work plan, and that it would review the level of the reserve every other year.

E. Liquidity position

12. Table 6 shows the Fund's gross liquid assets as at 31 December 1991, as compared to 1989 and 1990. As at 31 December 1991, UNFPA had bank balances in convertible currencies and time-deposit investments amounting to \$75.0 million, which included \$45.0 million of time-deposit investments of the operational reserve and \$7.6 million belonging to

UNFPA trust funds (see Annexes II and V). The investments reported in table 6 and in Annex II were recorded using the United Nations operational rate of exchange that came into effect on 1 December 1991. At the United Nations operational rate of exchange in effect from 1 January 1992, which more closely reflected the market rate of exchange as at 31 December 1991, the value of these investments would amount to \$398 more than that shown in the accounts.

F. Special population programmes

13. As authorized by the Governing Council at its seventeenth session (decision 74/16, paragraph (e)), UNFPA received cash remittances totalling \$37.0 million in 1991 from the Governments of Japan, the Netherlands and Norway to be transferred by UNFPA to designated special population programmes. The four recipients of these funds were the International Planned Parenthood Federation (\$36.0 million, from Japan and the Netherlands), The Population Council (\$0.5 million from the Netherlands and Norway), the International Union for the Scientific Study of Population (\$0.3 million from the Netherlands and Norway) and the International Council on Management of Population Programmes (\$0.2 million from Norway). These transfers of funds are not included in the UNFPA financial statements.

II. UNFPA TRUST FUNDS

14. Table 7 shows that in 1991 total income (contributions plus interest income) from donors for projects and activities under funds-in-trust arrangements was the equivalent of \$8.9 million, showing a decrease of \$2.9 million (24.6 per cent) compared to \$11.8 million received in 1990. As at 1 January 1991, the unexpended balance of the trust funds was \$10.9 million, which when added to the total income received under funds-in-trust agreements in 1991, resulted in a total amount available for programming in 1991 of \$19.8 million. Total expenditures were \$11.5 million in 1991 compared to \$11.3 million in 1990. Other transfers back to donor Governments in respect of completed projects totalled \$0.7 million, leaving an unexpended balance as at 31 December 1991 of \$7.6 million, which is available to finance trust fund activities in 1992. Annex V shows the statement of accounts as at 31 December 1991 for 20 trust funds managed by UNFPA in 1991, while Annex VI reflects the status of collections and unpaid pledges as at 31 December 1991.



There were no additions to the operational reserve in 1991. At its thirty-eighth session, the Governing Council in decision 91/36 decided that the level of the operational reserve should be set at 20 per cent of general resources income for each year of the UNFPA work plan, and that the level of the reserve would be reviewed every other year.
