I. INTRODUCTION

1. The tables which follow include a summary of statistics on technical cooperation project activities of the organizational entities of the United Nations and detailed information on the former Department of Technical Cooperation for Development (DTCD) of the United Nations Secretariat. The information was requested by the Governing Council in its decision 79/22 of 28 June 1979. The present report has been prepared in conjunction with other reports before the Council at its thirty-ninth session that contain basic programme data related to work financed by the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) and information on agency regular budget and non-UNDP extrabudgetary technical cooperation activities. An analysis of the DTCD programme delivery and administrative costs is included in the main text of the present report (DP/1992/35).
2. Financial data for the present document have been derived from the financial statements for the year ending 31 December 1991.
3. In 1991, the organizational entities of the United Nations delivered a technical cooperation programme of \$285 million, compared with \$277 million in 1990. This represents 3 per cent increase in project expenditures.
4. Of this amount, DTCD executed a programme of \$178.1 million. Projects financed by UNDP represented \$119.6 million; projects financed by the United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA) accounted for \$23.2 million; \$28.4 million was financed by trust funds; and \$6.9 million was expended under the United Nations Regular Programme of Technical Cooperation.
5. On a geographical basis, the DTCD-executed programme in 1991 included expenditures of \$83.5 million in Africa; \$50.7 million in Asia and the Pacific; \$34.3 million in the Middle East, Mediterranean, Europe and Interregional; and \$9.6 million in the Americas. The largest growth was in Africa, where the programme increased by \$7.4 million. Project delivery in Africa also remained the largest, with a 47 per cent share of the total delivery.
6. The distribution of project expenditures by substantive sectors was the following: natural resources and energy, \$63.1 million; development planning, \$37.1 million; statistics \$26 million; public administration and finance, \$25.0 million; population, \$10.7 million; social development, \$5.8 million; the United Nations Educational and Training Programme for Southern Africa (UNETPSA), \$5.5 million; and others, \$4.9 million. Natural resources and energy, which includes work in minerals, energy, water and infrastructure, comprised 35 per cent of the DTCD total, and remained the largest programme; development planning continued to be second.

. On a component basis, DTCD delivery in 1991 included \$94.9 million for project personnel, \$29.2 million for equipment, \$32.1 million for training, \$12.3 million for subcontracted services and \$9.6 million for miscellaneous expenses. The component which showed the largest growth was training, which rose by \$5.3 million. The proportion of total expenditures increased for training by 20 per cent; subcontracts by 19 per cent; and personnel by 1 per cent; that for equipment decreased by 27 per cent.

3. Information on participation in the programme from developing countries and by women is as follows: equipment purchased in developing countries totalled \$15.5 million or 48 per cent of the total. Of the 1,658 international project personnel serving during the year, 681, or 41 per cent, were from developing countries and 132, or 8 per cent, were female. Of the total of 5,312 training placements made during the year, 2,877, or 54 per cent, were for study in developing countries. The trainees themselves numbered 4,739 and of these 944, or 20 per cent, were female.

by Source of Funds**




Fig.2. DTCD Project Expenditures by Field of Activity




Fig.3. DTCD Project Expenditures by Region





Fig.4. DTCD Project Expenditures by Component

from developing countries**





Fig.6. DTCD training placements :

countries**




Fig.8. DTCID subcontracts :
