ASSISTANCE TO THE UNION OF MYANMAR

Note by the Administrator

- 1. The fifth country programme for Myanmar was approved at the special session of the Governing Council in February 1987 for the programme period 1987 to 1991.
- 2. Given the current situation in Myanmar and the absence of a national development plan, the Administrator, with the concurrence of the Government, proposes that until further notice UNDP assistance be provided on a project-by-project basis.
- 3. The Administrator wishes, therefore, to seek the Governing Council's authorization to approve assistance to Myanmar on a project-by-project basis, guided by Council decision 90/34 and within the limits of the annual pro rata distribution of the indicative planning figure for Myanmar in the fifth programming cycle. The Administrator assures the Council that the situation will be reviewed on a continuing basis; as soon as conditions permit, the regular country programming process will be resumed.
