TRUST FUNDS ESTABLISHED BY THE ADMINISTRATOR IN 1991

Report of the Administrator

## SUMMARY

The present document contains information on those trust funds established by the Administrator in 1991 under the authority granted to him in 1981 by regulation 5.1 of the revised Financial Regulations of the United Nations Development Programme. Summary financial information on all trust funds Established by the Administrator since 1981 is provided in CRP.3.

#### INTRODUCTION

- Regulation 5.1 of the Financial Regulations of the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP), which the Governing Council adopted by its decision 81/28 of 30 June 1981, gives the Administrator the authority to establish trust funds for specified ourposes consistent with the policies, aims, and activities of UNDP.
- The present report, covers all trust funds established by the Administrator during the preceding calendar year. A brief description of the activities of each trust fund is provided below and summary information on each trust fund is contained in annex I to the present document.
- Annex II provides information concerning individual projects financed by the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics/UNDP Trust Fund for Training in the USSR of Specialists From Developing Countries, which was established in 1982.
- In accordance with regulation 5.1, this report has been submitted to the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions (ACABQ).
  - I. TRUST FUNDS ESTABLISHED ON BEHALF OF THE UNITED NATIONS DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME
  - A. <u>UNDP Trust Fund for the Independent International</u>
    <u>Commission on Health Research for Developing Countries</u>
- This trust fund was established to cover the costs of international experts and administrative support services for the lask Force on Health Research and Development.
  - B. <u>UNDP/JAIDO Trust Fund for Sea Island Cotton Pilot Production</u>
- This trust fund was established to obtain necessary cechnical and managerial experience and capacity to expand rapidly the volume, quantity and efficiency of cotton production in the cominican Republic.

# C. Trust Fund for Environmental Conservation in Bhutan

7. This trust fund was established to preserve Bhutan's extensive forest cover by providing funds for a comprehensive range of conservation activities.

# D. Trust Fund for the Global Environment Facility

8. This trust fund was established to support pre-investment studies and other technical co-operation activities designed projects to assist developing countries protect the global environment and to use environmentally benign technologies. Assistance will be provided in the following areas: global warming biodiversity, international water pollution and ozone depletion.

## E. Enhancement of Private Sector Role in Development

9. This trust fund was established to provide technical assistance to governments and organizations in the development of a supporting environment for private sector development, privatization in its broadest meaning, improvement of financial systems, business development, expansion of UNISTAR and support to TOKTEN.

# F. UNDP Trust Fund for Technological Information Pilot System (TIPS)

10. This trust fund was established to institute the DEVNET/TIPS information network which collects and disseminates information on trade and technology to developing countries. DEVNET/TIPS closely coordinates its activities with INRES-SOUTH (a TCDC information referral service) and TIN (Trade Information Network) and is expected to enhance the capacities of the participating countries in the fields of Trade and Technology and to catalyze economic and technical co-operation among these countries.

### G. World Maritime University Trust Fund

11. This trust fund was established to provide support to the World Maritime University in Malmo, Sweden.

# H. Trust Fund for the Interim Multilateral Fund under the Montreal Protocol

12. This trust fund was established to support feasibility and pre-investment studies and other technical assistance measures in accordance with the criteria and guidelines adopted by the Executive Committee of the Interim Multilateral Fund under the Montreal Protocol.

## I. <u>Disaster Management Training Programme</u>

- 13. This trust fund was established to implement Disaster Management Training Programmes in Africa.
  - J. <u>Government of Germany Trust Fund for UNDP/World Bank</u> <u>Energy Sector Management Assistance Programme</u>
- 14. This trust fund was established to provide support through the Energy Sector Management Assistance Programme (ESMAP) for the implementation of energy efficiency and conservation programmes in Pakistan, Philippines and other developing countries.
  - K. <u>Elaboration of Methods and Techniques of</u>
    <u>Operationalizing the Human Development Concept</u>
- 15. This trust fund was established to promote the design of planning tools and policy instruments required to translate the human development from a policy concern into practical action.
  - II. TRUST FUNDS ESTABLISHED ON BEHALF OF THE UNITED NATIONS REVOLVING FUND FOR NATURAL RESOURCES EXPLORATION

### A. UNRFNRE Environmental Protection Guidelines

16. This trust fund was established to support the preparation of environmental guidelines for use in the design and appraisal of UNRFNRE projects.

# B. Mineral Exploration in the SADCC Region

- 17. This trust fund was established to provide technical cooperation to interested governments and organizations for mineral exploration in the Southern African Development Consultative Conference (SADCC) region, promotion of investments in the mineral sector of SADCC countries and enhancement of regional co-operation relating to mineral exploration.
  - III. TRUST FUNDS ESTABLISHED ON BEHALF OF THE UNITED NATIONS VOLUNTEERS PROGRAMME
  - A. <u>UNV Technical Support to Refugee Relief and Humanitarian</u>
    Assistance in <u>South East Asia</u>
- 18. This trust fund was established to contribute to the relief, repatriation and rehabilitation efforts with special emphasis on support of refugees from countries in the Indo-China region.
  - B. <u>UNV Technical Support to the Regional Humanitarian Plan</u> of Action Relating to the Crisis between Iraq and Kuwait
- 19. This trust fund was established to provide support to United Nations agencies, governments and non-governmental organizations engaged in relief efforts. The support will include volunteer technicians and professionals who will be involved in the implementation of relief programmes in Iran, Jordan, Syria and Turkey.
  - C. <u>Preparatory Assistance for the formulation of Urban</u> Environmental Pilot Project
- 20. This trust fund was established for the recruitment of two consultants in the Caribbean and South East Asia to formulate seven pilot projects to address issues of urban poverty and environment through community-based initiatives.

- D. UNV Technical Support to the Regional Humanitarian Assistance relating to the crisis originating in Iraq/Kuwait
- 21. This trust fund was established for UNV specialists to support projects of UNHCR, WFP and other UN agencies and international organizations. These specialists will work primarily in logistics, camp site management, legal protection, water supply and sanitation.
  - E. Humanitarian Assistance in the Gulf Region

- 22. This trust fund was established to support refugees and displaced persons in the Gulf region.
  - Netherlands Facility for UNV Support from Central Europe F. to Developing Countries
- This trust fund was established to finance United Nations Volunteers from Central Europe to developing and least developed countries.
  - G. Netherlands Support for UNV/Domestic Development Services
- This trust fund was established for the provision of 4. fourteen UNV Domestic Development Services (DDS) field workers, orking in UNV/DDS projects.
  - UNV Multi-Sectoral Technical Support for Development and Η. Humanitarian Assistance
- This trust fund was established to provide expertise to 5. elected development and humanitarian assistance projects in the ield of education, health, agriculture, animal husbandry, public orks and vocational training.

### I. Canada/Liberian Emergency Relief Trust Fund

26. This trust fund was established to meet part of the costs of project LIR/91/VO4, which assists the distribution, monitoring and effective management of emergency relief supplies to displaced people and returning residents of Liberia.

## J. United Kingdom/Liberian Emergency Relief Trust Fund

- 27. This trust fund was established to meet part of the costs of project LIR/91/VO4, which assists the distribution, monitoring and effective management of emergency relief supplies to displaced people and returning residents of Liberia.
  - IV. TRUST FUND ESTABLISHED ON BEHALF OF THE UNITED NATIONS FUND FOR SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY FOR DEVELOPMENT
  - A. <u>International Conference Series on Environmentally Sound Coal Technologies for China and India</u>
- 28. This trust fund was established to strengthen indigenous capacities to manage coal related energy production and consumption, facilitating China and India's efforts to enhance coal related energy efficiency as well as the reduction of environmental stress.
