EXTENSION OF THE FOURTH COUNTRY PROGRAMME FOR BARBADOS

Note by the Administrator

- 1. The fourth country programme for Barbados was approved by the Governing Council at its thirty-third session (1986) for the period 1987 to 1991. A UNDP mission visited Barbados to review arrangements for the fifth country programme, in accordance with Governing Council decision 91/29 on net contributor country status. The visit resulted in a United Nations Development Programme <u>aide-mémoire</u>, which is under consideration by the Government. The Government has therefore requested that the fourth country programme be extended for a period of one year to allow time for these negotiations to be concluded successfully.
- 2. The objectives of the fourth country programme remain valid for the duration of the extension. They are (a) agricultural diversification; (b) industrial diversification; and (c) expansion, strengthening and streamlining of the services sector.
- 3. It is expected that the fifth country programme will be submitted to the Governing Council at its special session in February 1993.
- 4. The Administrator wishes to inform the Governing Council that he has approved the extension of the fourth country programme for Barbados for a period of one year, beginning 1 January 1992.
