EXTENSION OF THE SECOND COUNTRY PROGRAMME FOR THE BAHAMAS

Note by the Administrator

- 1. The second country programme for the Bahamas was approved by the Governing Council at its thirty-fourth session (1987) for the period 1987 to 1991. In accordance with decision 91/29 of 25 June 1992, which dealt with net contributor country status, negotiations are taking place with the Government regarding the formulation of the third country programme. Pending the outcome of these discussions, the Government has requested that the second country programme be extended for one year. The objectives of the second country programme, related to human resources development and water resources development, will remain valid for the period of the extension.
- 2. It is expected that the third country programme will be submitted to the Governing Council at its fortieth session (1993).
- 3. The Administrator wishes to inform the Governing Council that he has approved the extension of the second country programme for the Bahamas for a period of one year, beginning 1 January 1992.
