EXTENSION OF THE FOURTH COUNTRY PROGRAMME FOR GUYANA

Note by the Administrator

- 1. The fourth country programme for Guyana was approved by the Governing Council at its special session in February 1987 for the period 1987 to 1991. The process leading to the formulation of the fifth programme has been delayed since preparations for general elections have been the focus of national attention. The Government has therefore requested that the fourth programme be extended by one year to allow time for the finalization of the fifth country programme following the national elections.
- 2. The two objectives of the fourth country programme remain relevant and central to the country's development strategy for the period of the extension. These objectives are (a) optimizing outputs of the productive sector and (b) improving public sector planning and management.
- 3. It is expected that the fifth country programme will be submitted to the Governing Council at its special session in February 1993.
- 4. The Administrator wishes to inform the Governing Council that he has approved an extension of the fourth country programme for Guyana for a period of one year, beginning 1 January 1992.
