EXTENSION OF THE THIRD COUNTRY PROGRAMME FOR SAO TOME AND PRINCIPE

Note by the Administrator

- 1. The third country programme for Sao Tome and Principe covers the period from 1987 to 1991. The Government has requested a one-year extension in order to incorporate in the fourth country programme the conclusions of the round-table meeting and sectoral consultations of donors to be held in 1992. During the one-year extension the central themes of the third country programme will be continued, namely: the strengthening of economic management; support to agricultural production; support to industrial production and services; and the strengthening of transport and communications.
- 2. The Administrator wishes to inform the Governing Council that he has approved the extension of the third country programme for Sao Tome and Principe for a period of one year, beginning 1 January 1992.
