EXTENSION OF THE FOURTH COUNTRY PROGRAMME FOR TOGO

Note by the Administrator

- 1. The fourth country programme for Togo was approved at the thirty-fourth session of the Governing Council for the period January 1987 to December 1991.
- 2. A national conference in mid-1991 led to the establishment of a new Government, in which changes were made at the end of the year. In the light of these developments, the Government has requested a one-year extension of the fourth country programme. During this period, the main objectives of the fourth country programme will continue to be relevant, namely national capacity-building and human resources development with special emphasis on social and environmental issues.
- 3. The Administrator wishes to inform the Governing Council that he has approved the extension of the fourth country programme for Togo for a period of one year, beginning 1 January 1992.
